

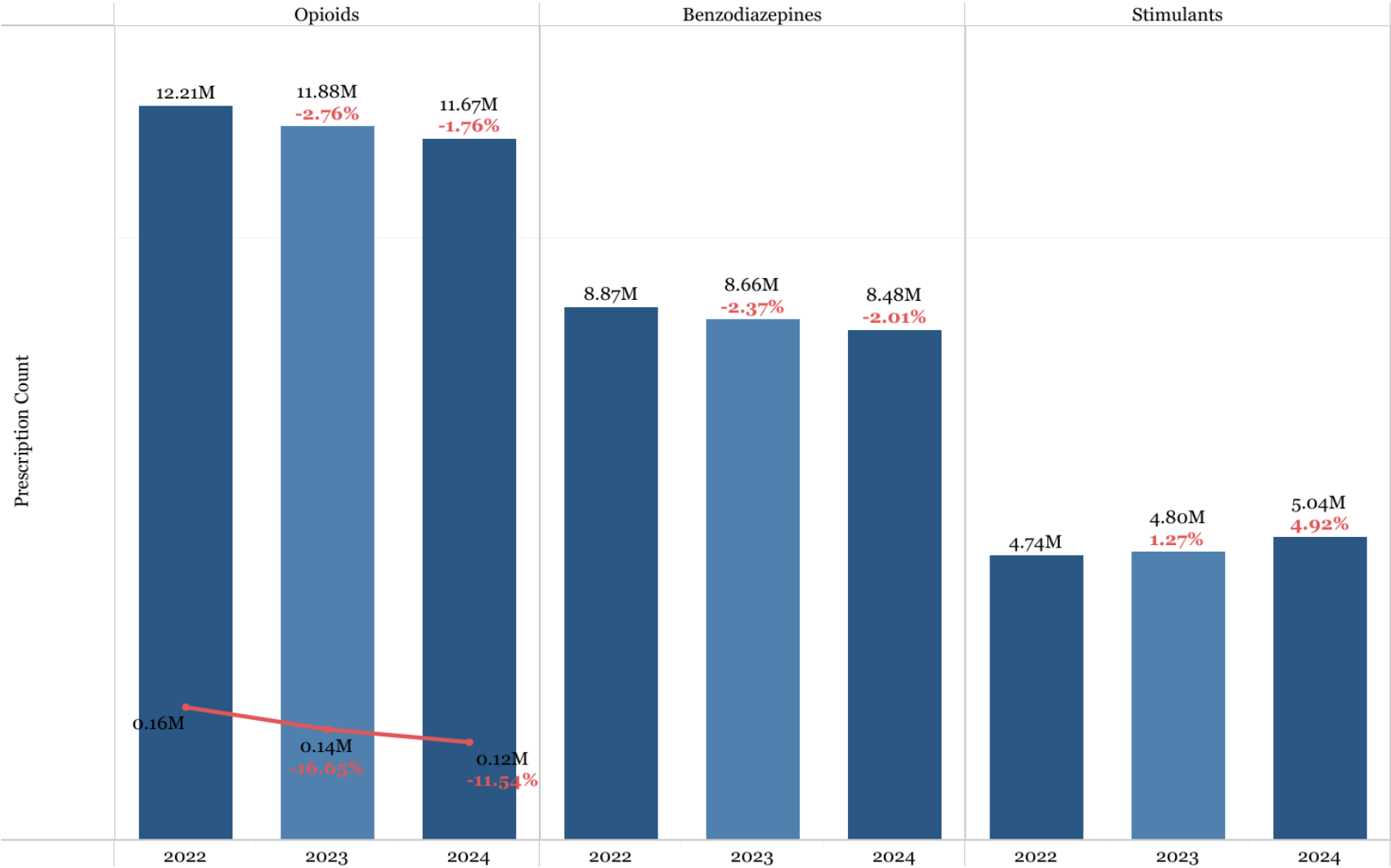
Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

Prescriptions by Drug Type & Year

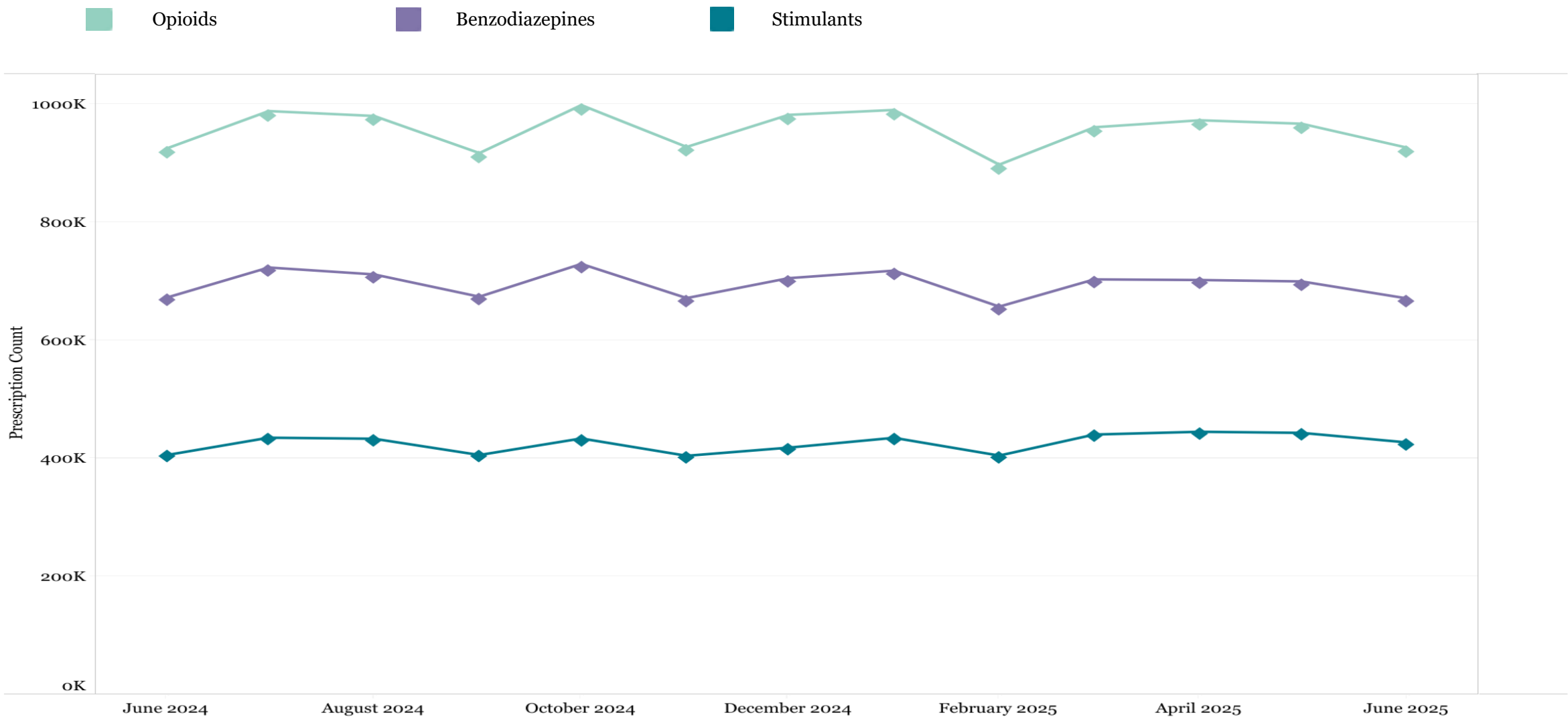

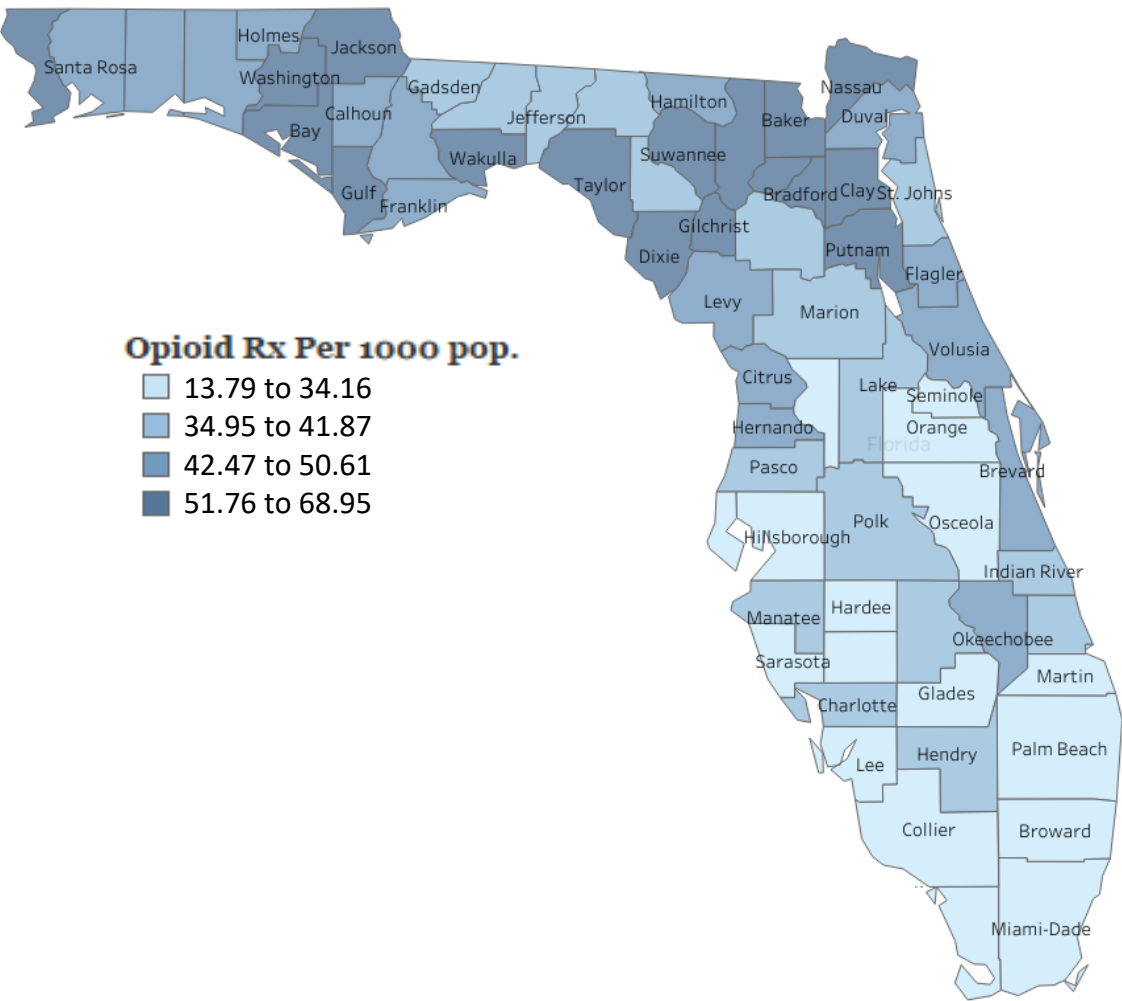

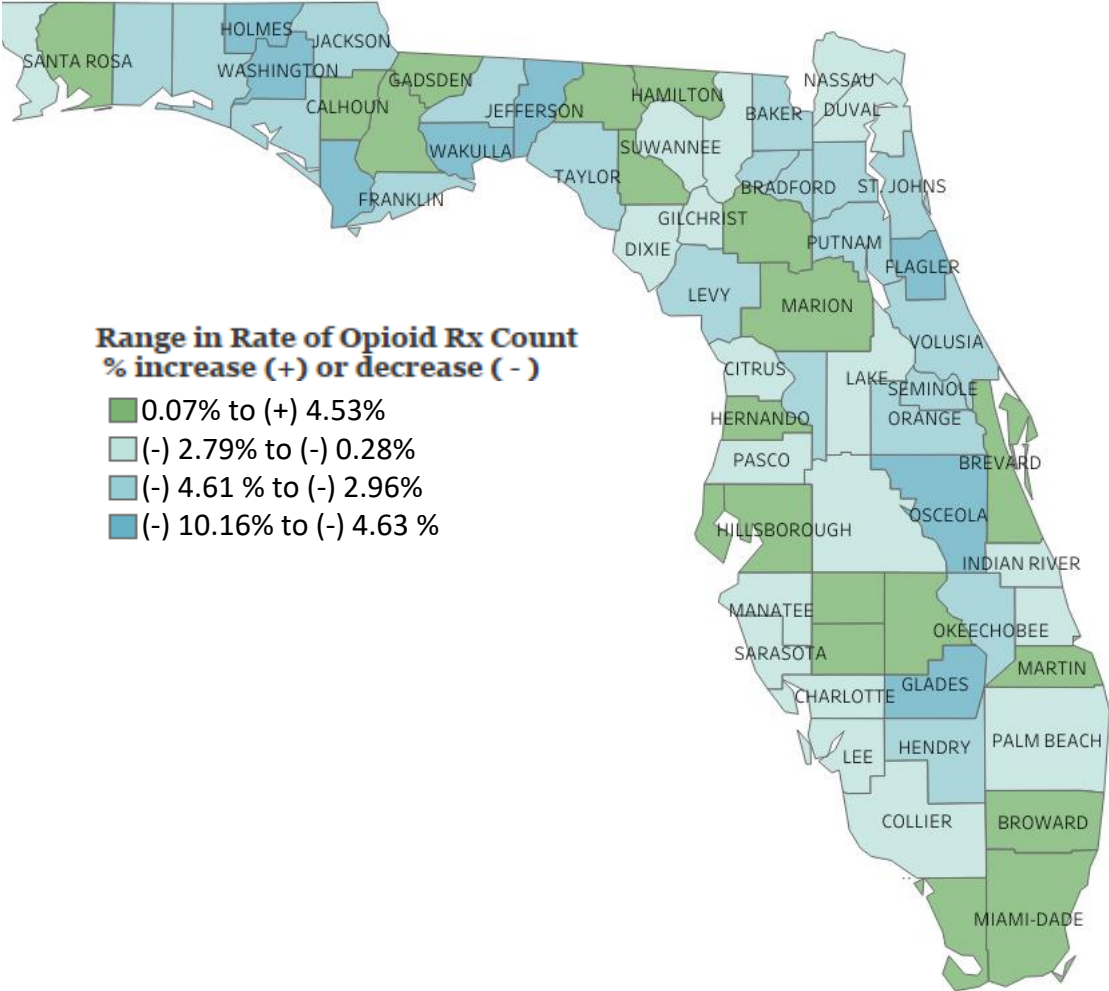

June 2025



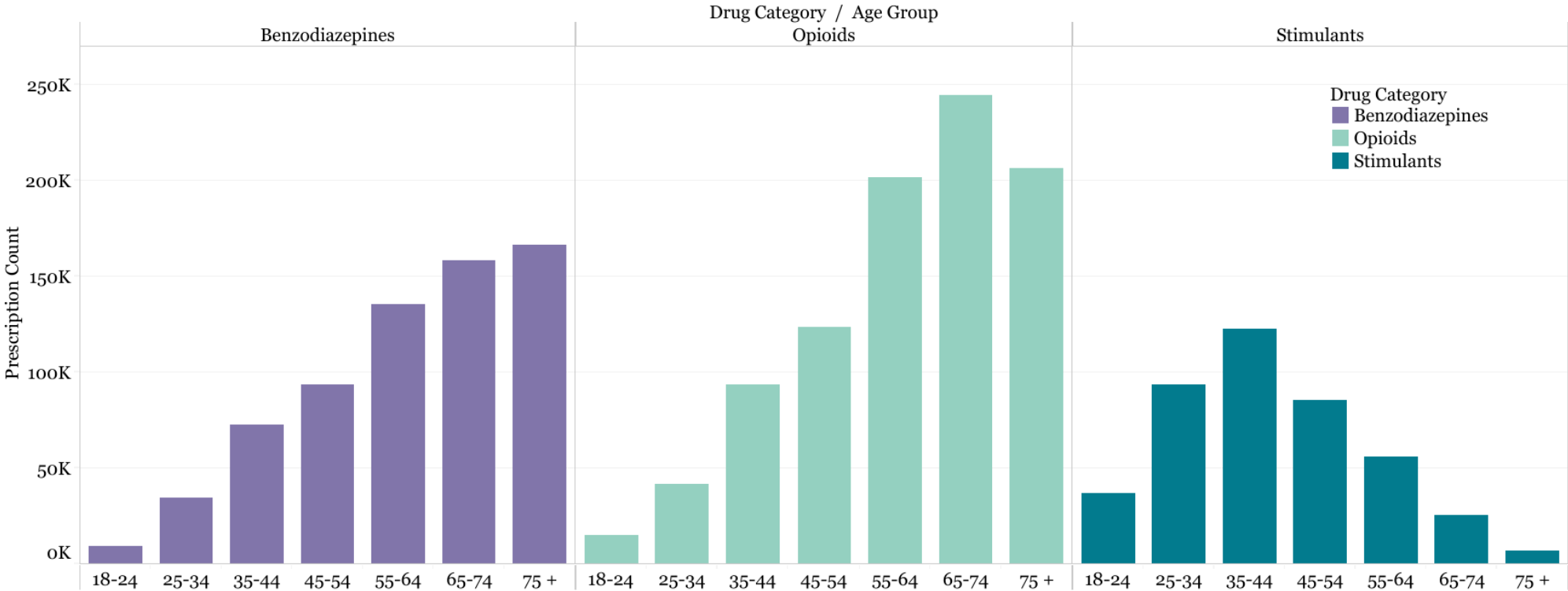
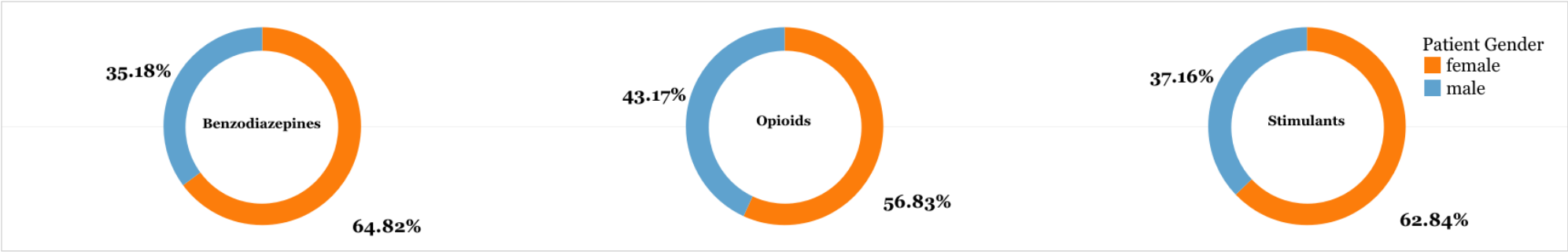
