

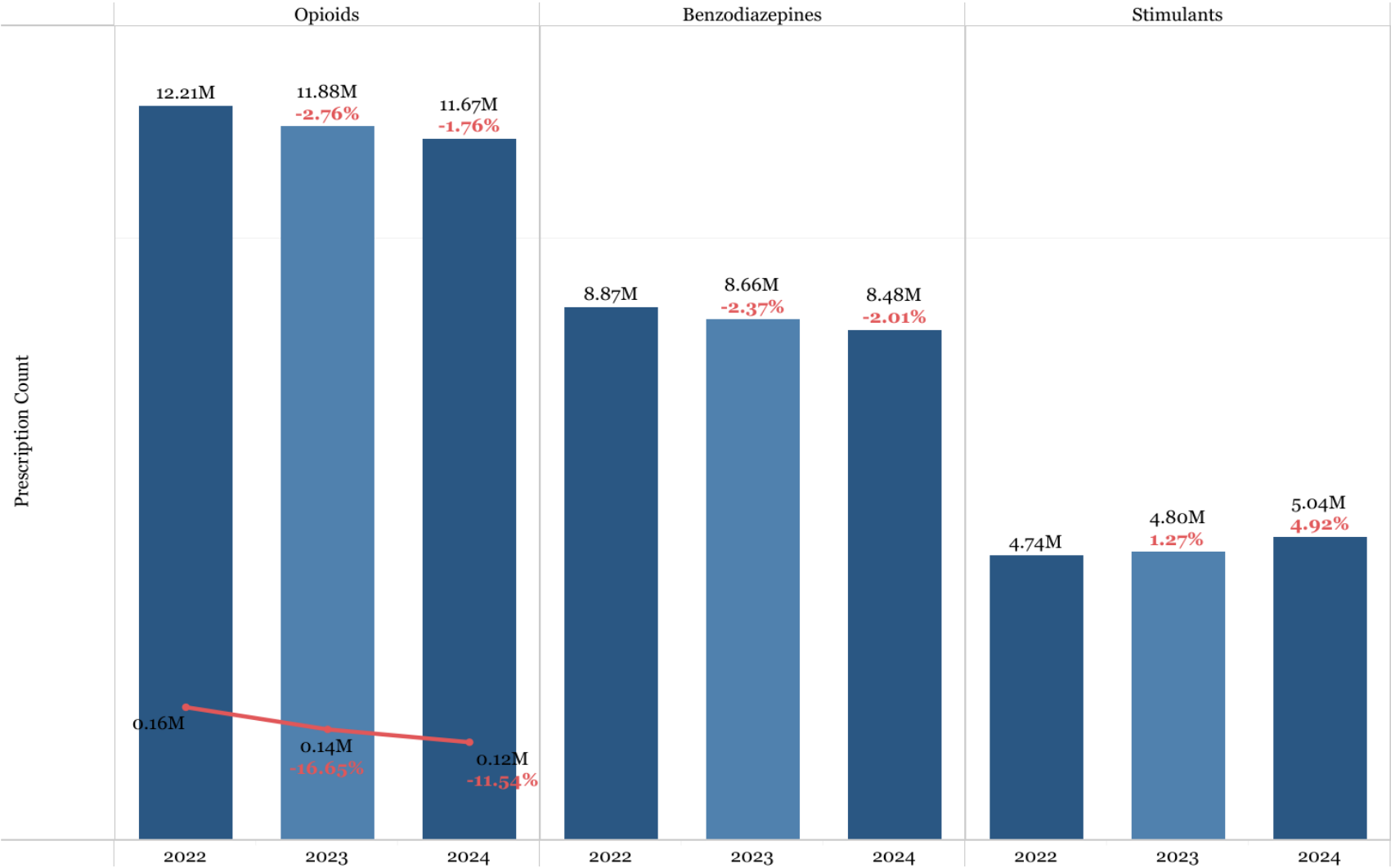
Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

Prescriptions by Drug Type & Year

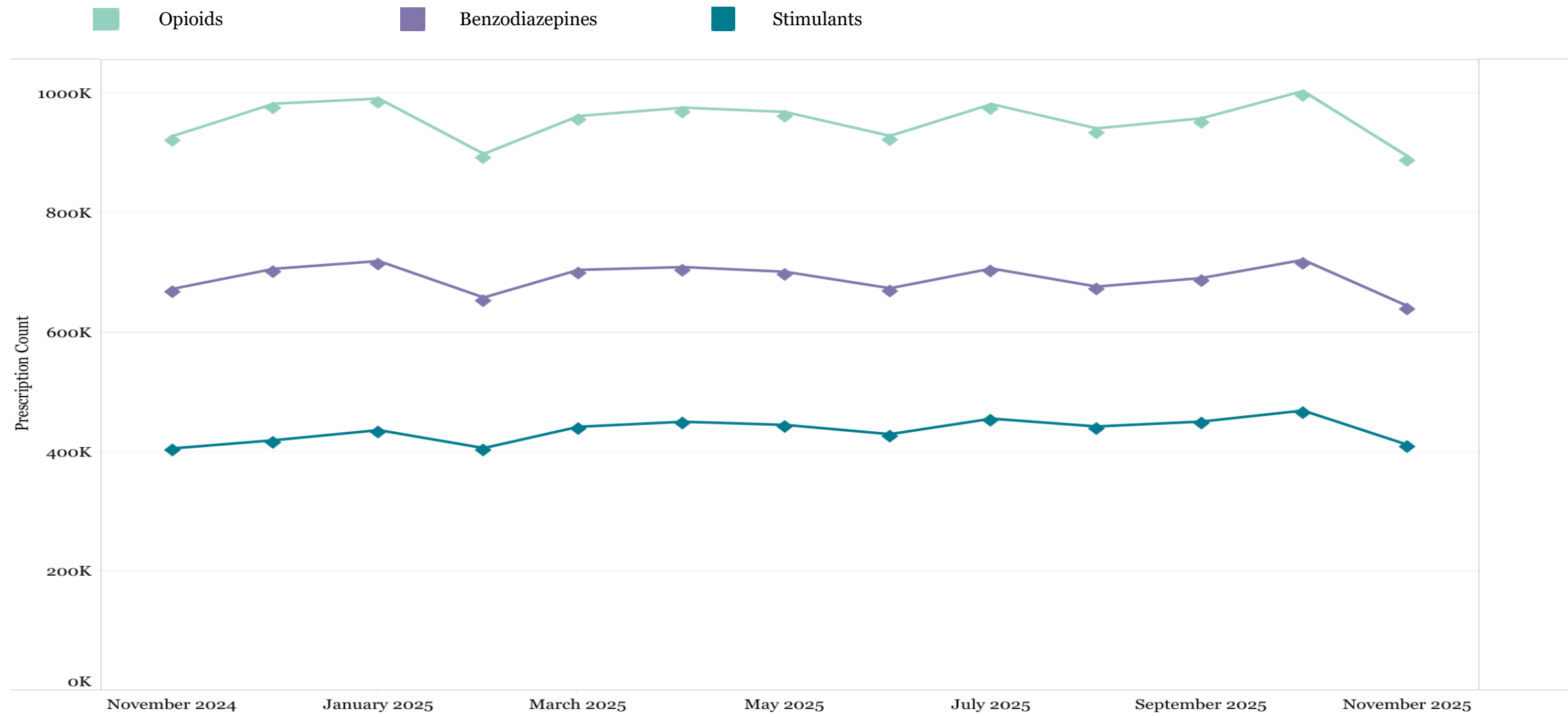
Florida, 2022-2024

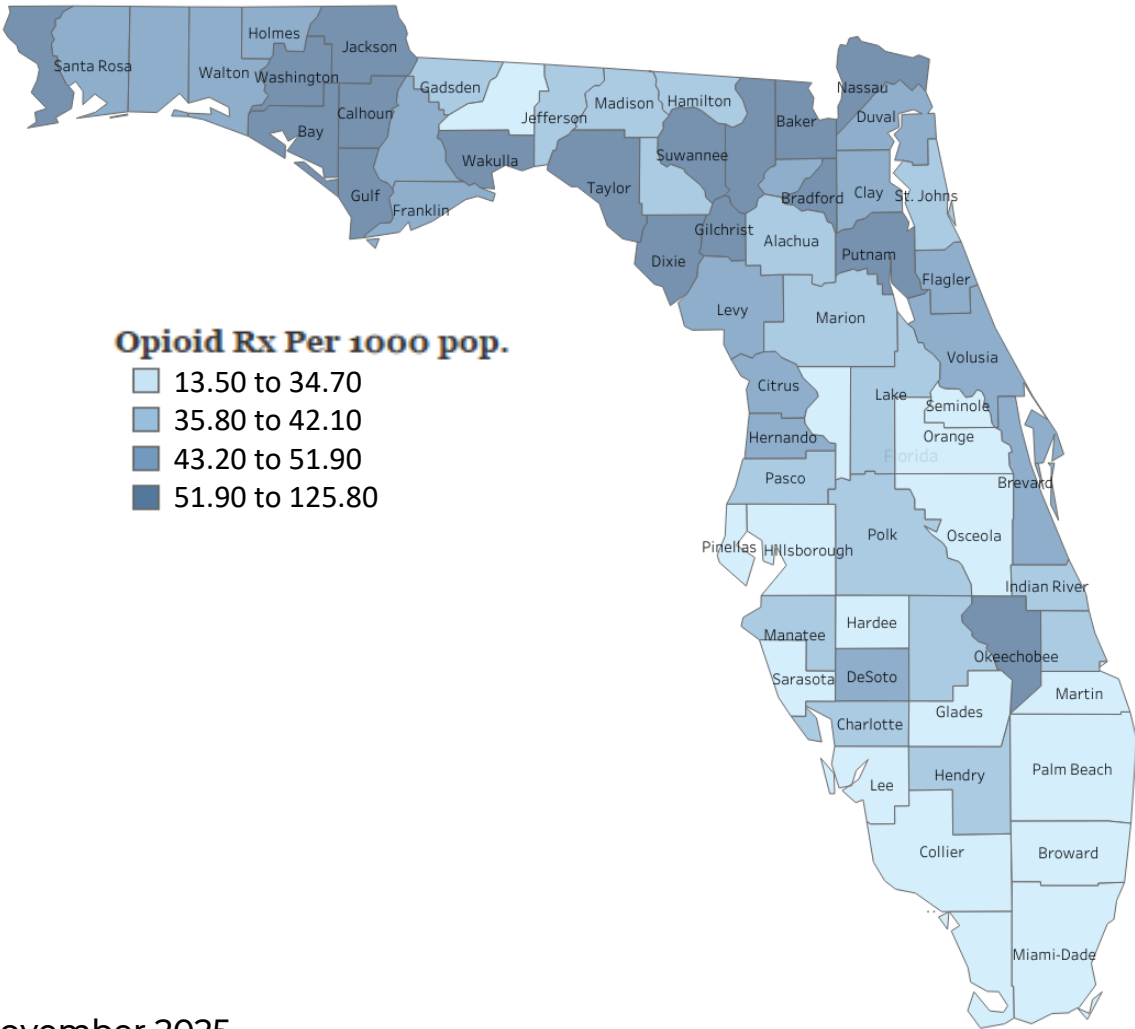

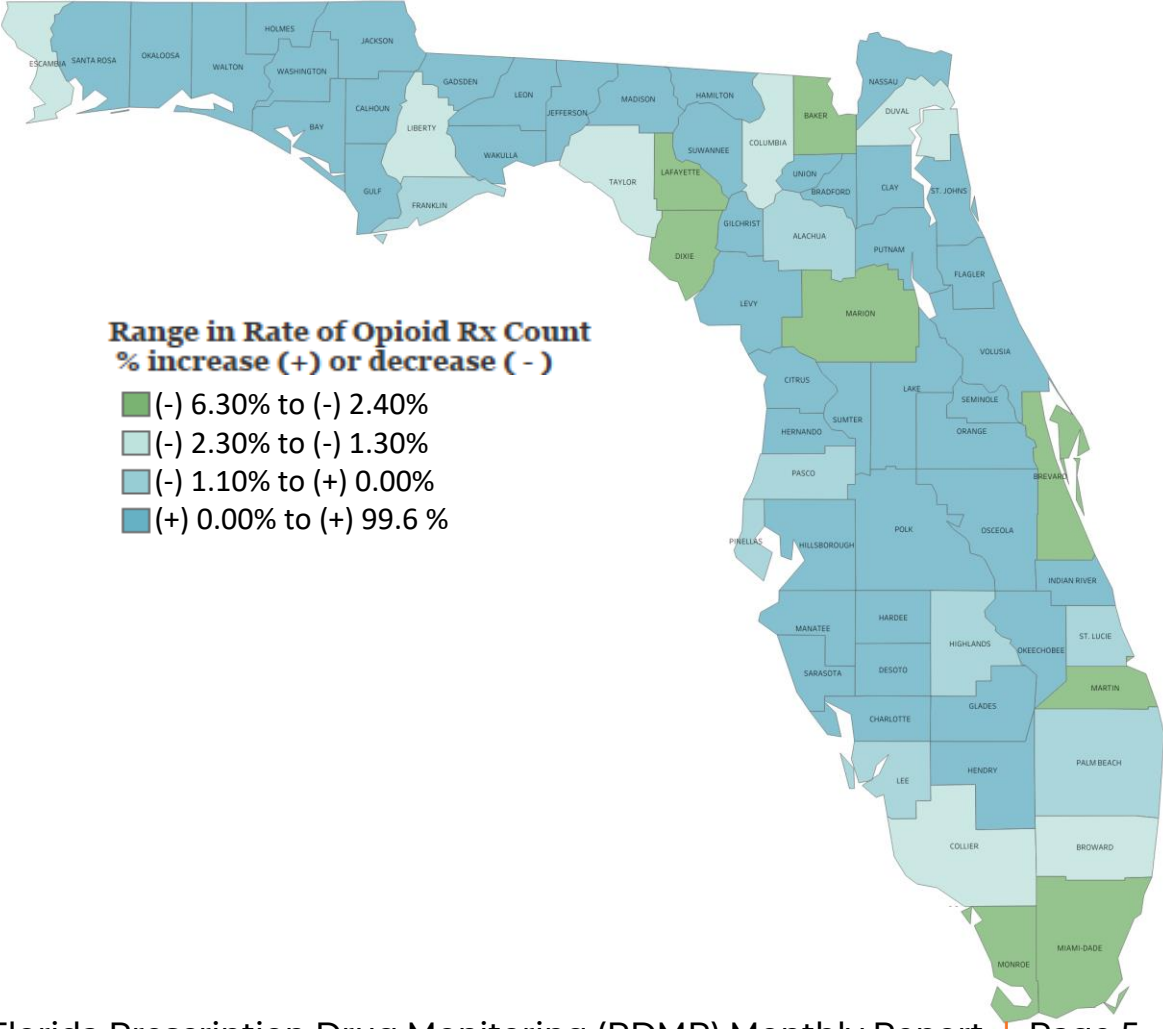
Opioid Prescription Rate & Percent Change by County

September 2025

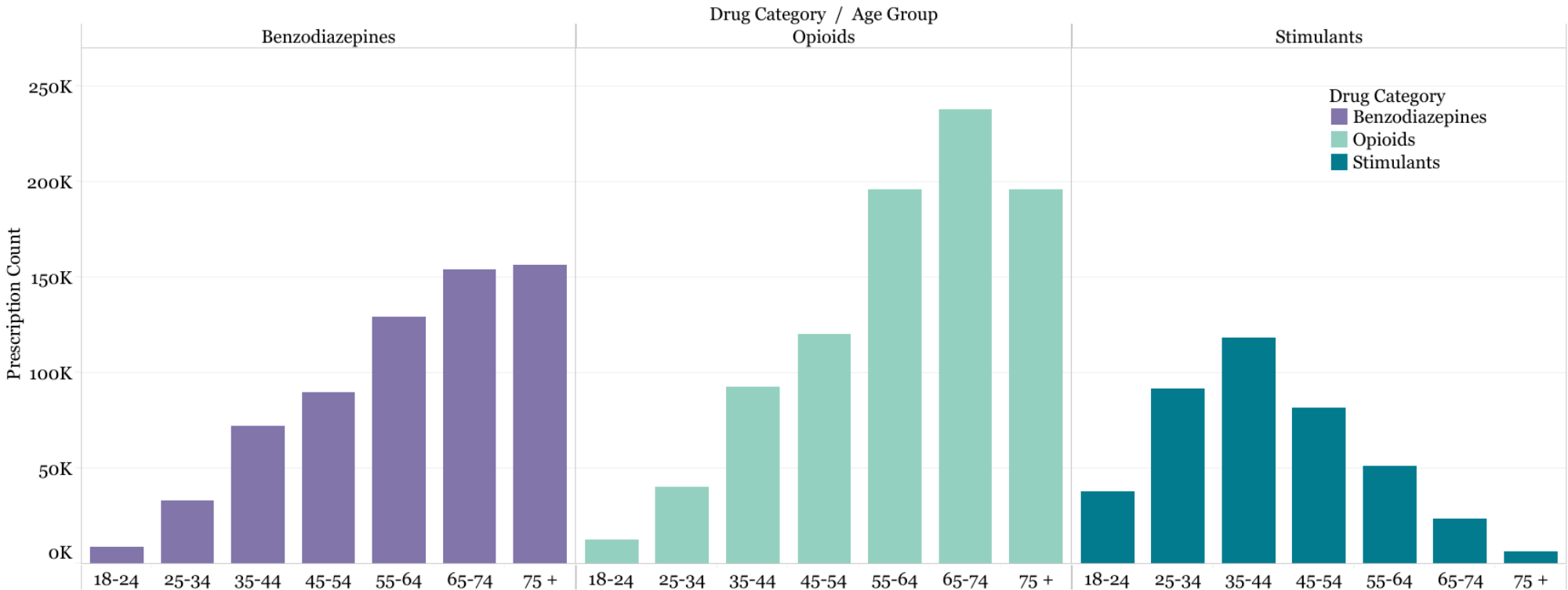
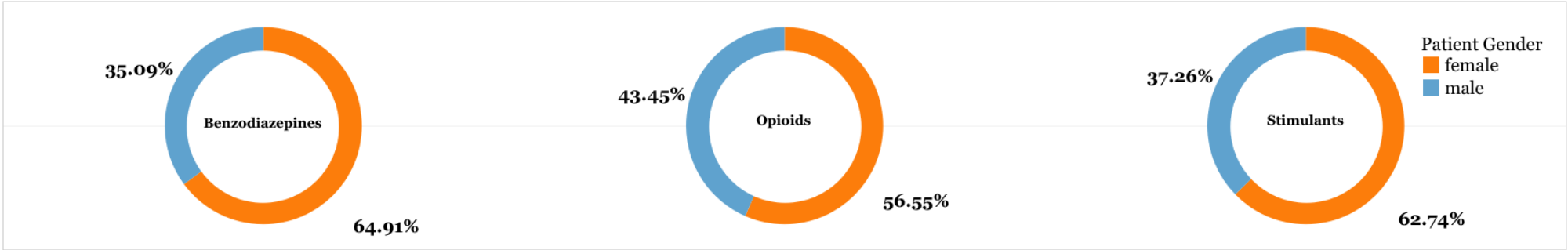


Percent Change in Opioid Prescription Count by County, Florida
