

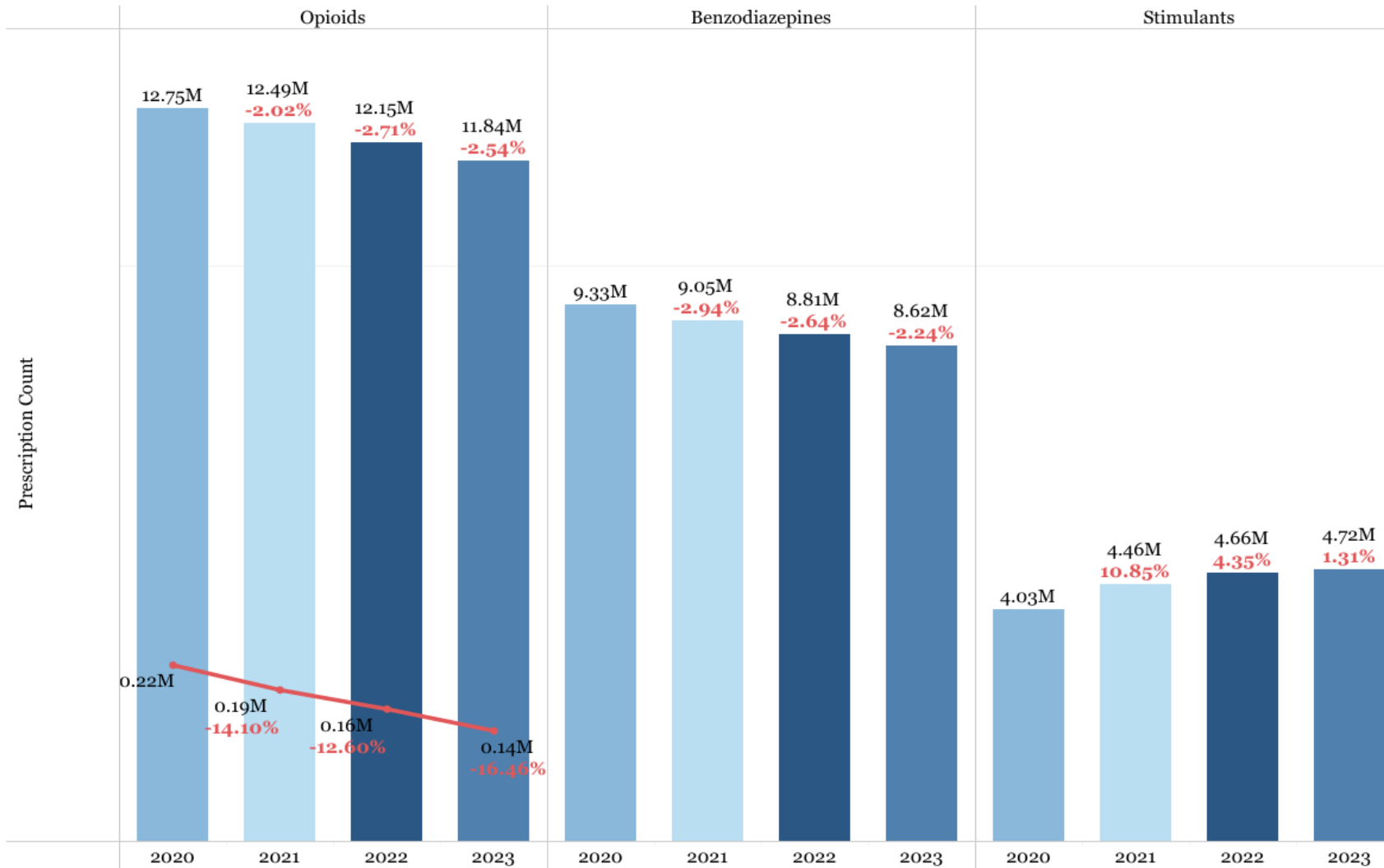
Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

Florida, 2020-2023

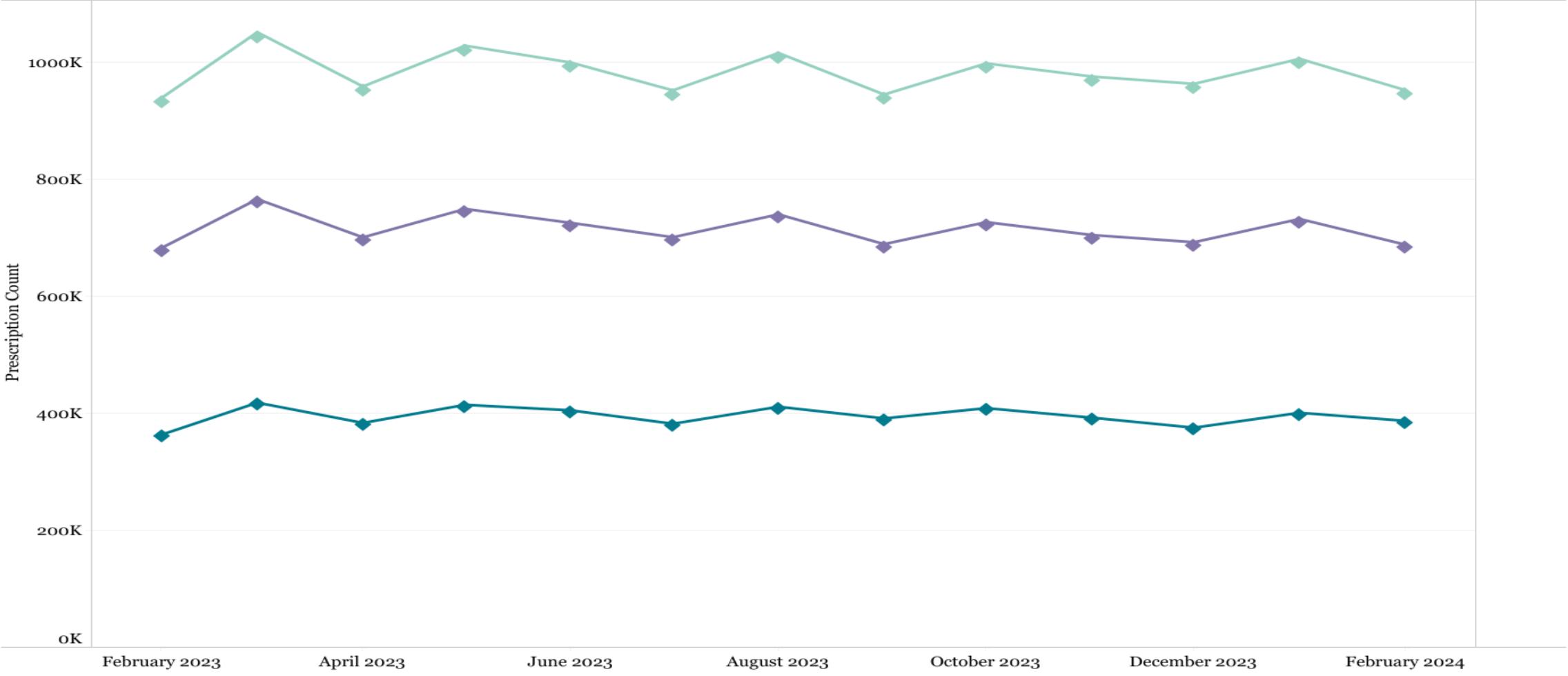


- The red line represents the number of fentanyl prescriptions.

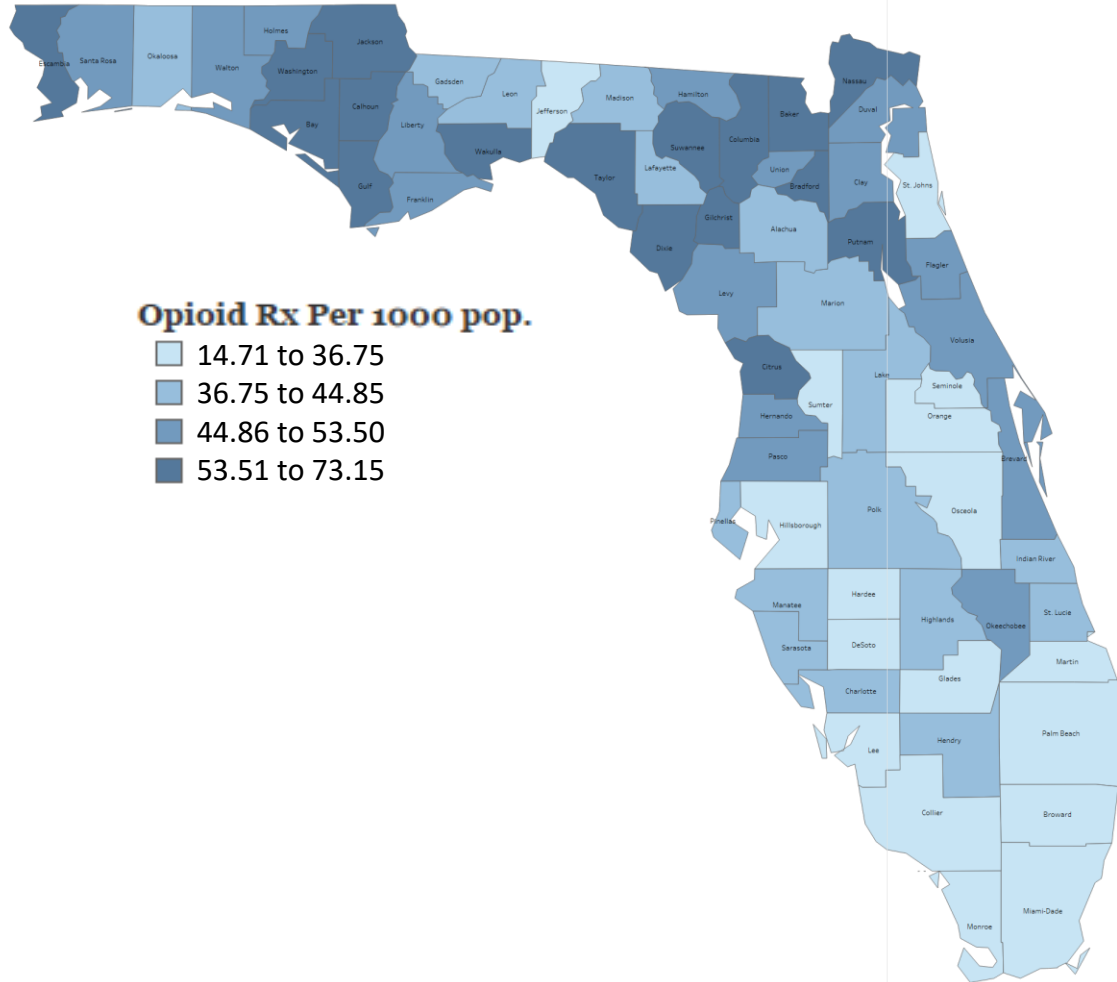

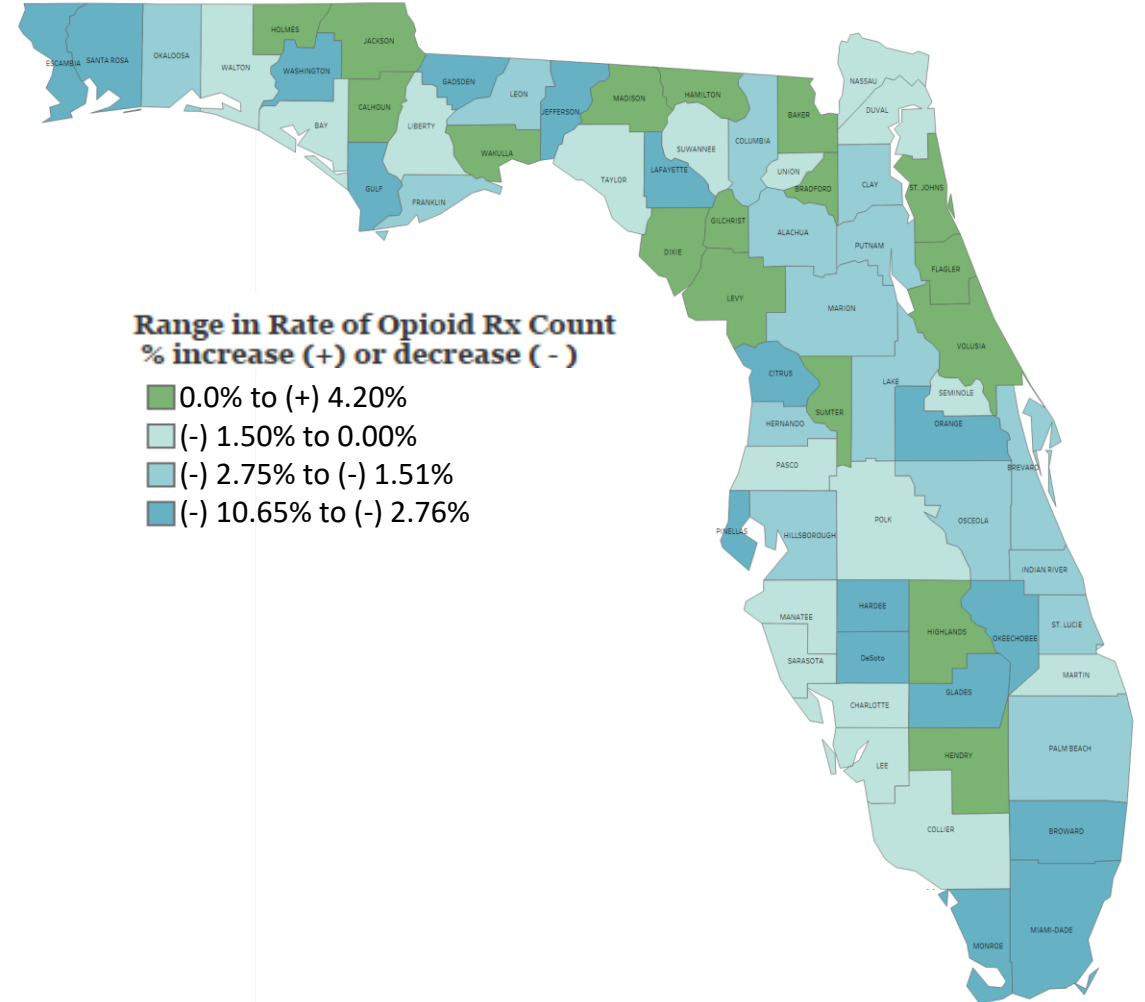
Opioid Prescription Rate & Percent Change by County*

February, 2024**

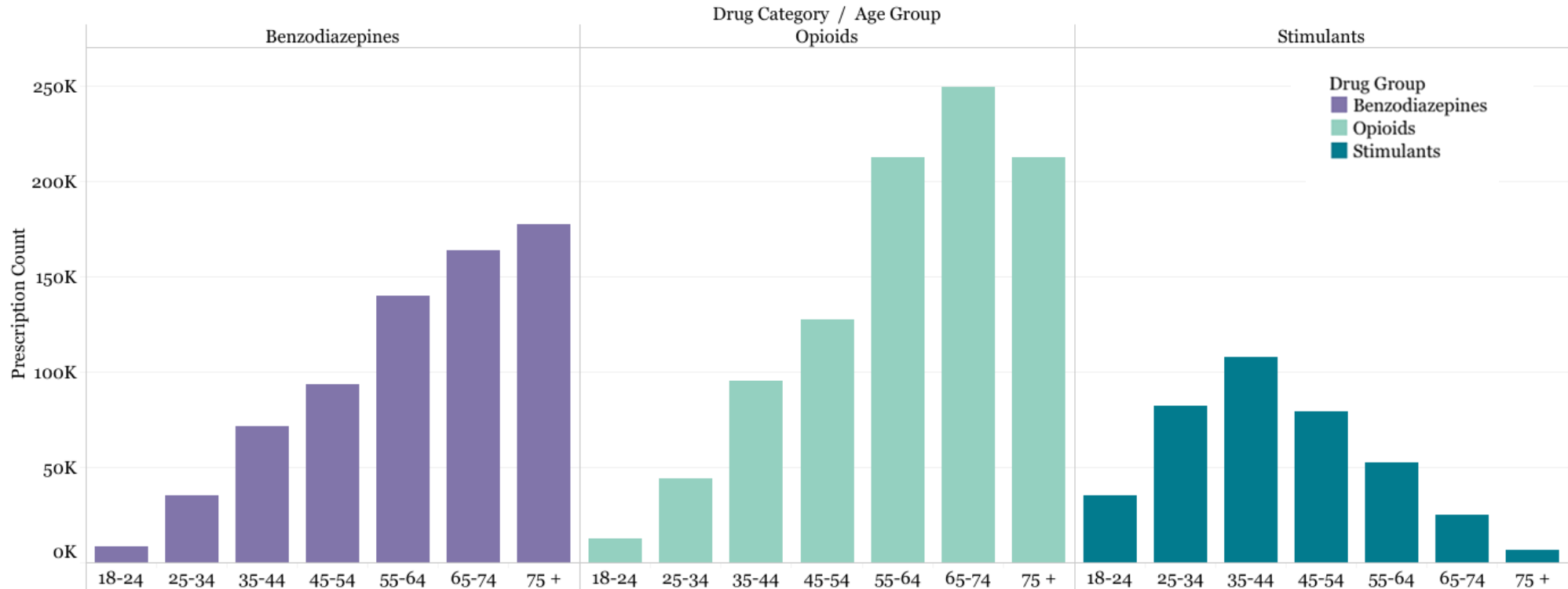
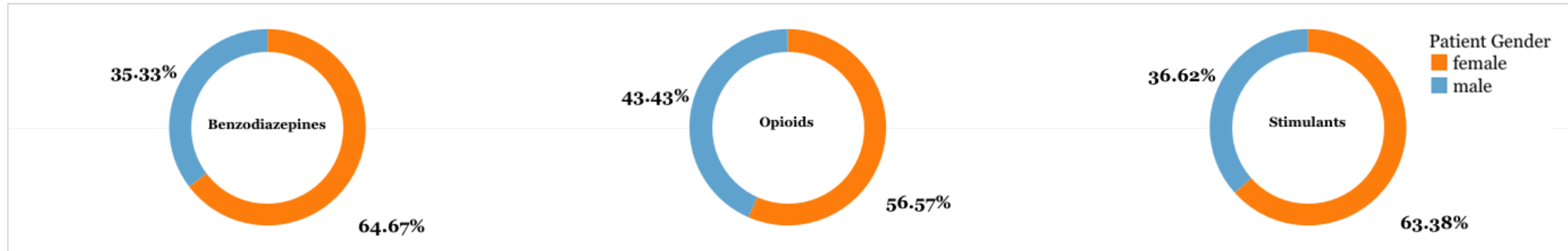


**Percent Change in Opioid Prescription Count by County, Florida
