

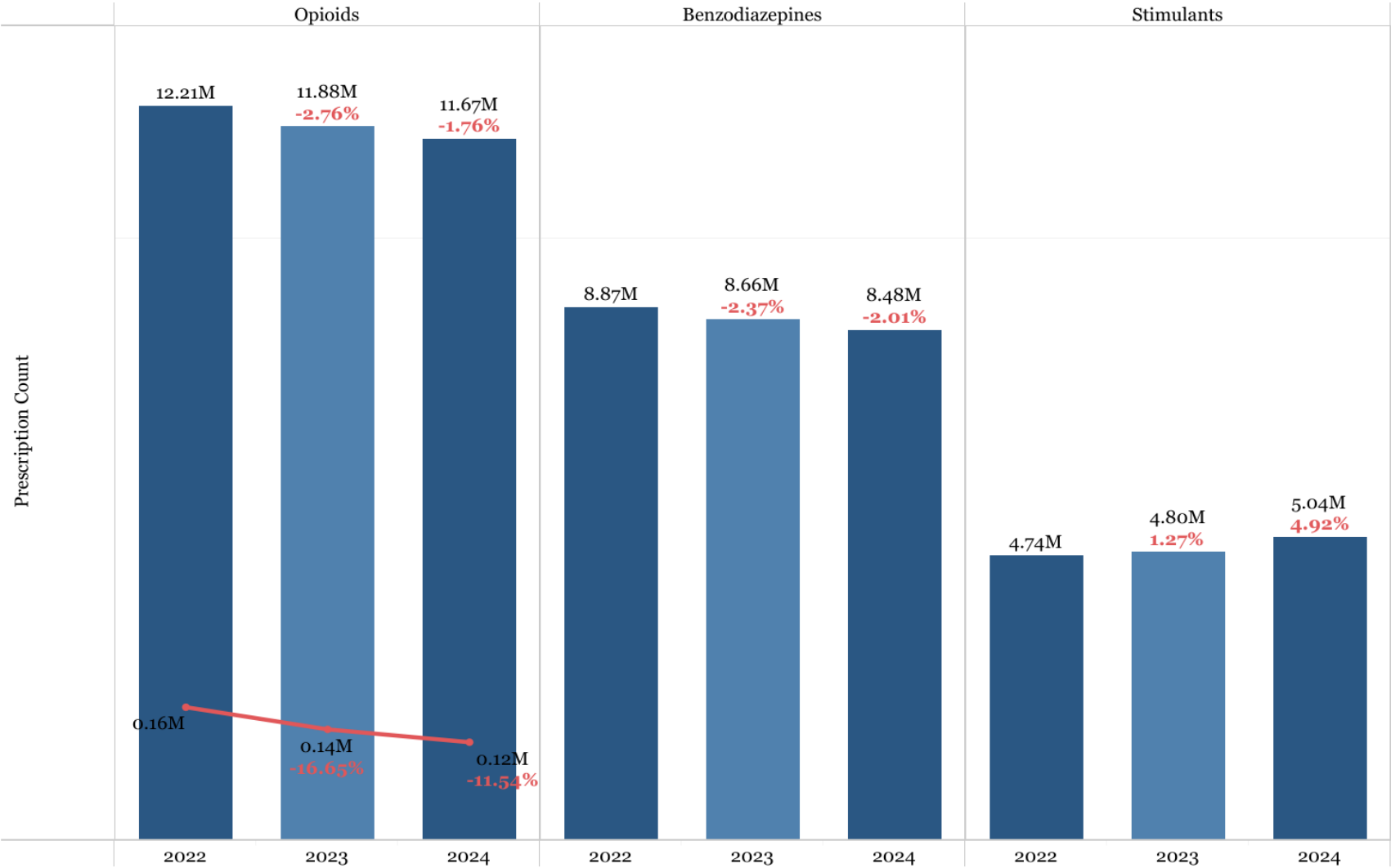
Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

Prescriptions by Drug Type & Year

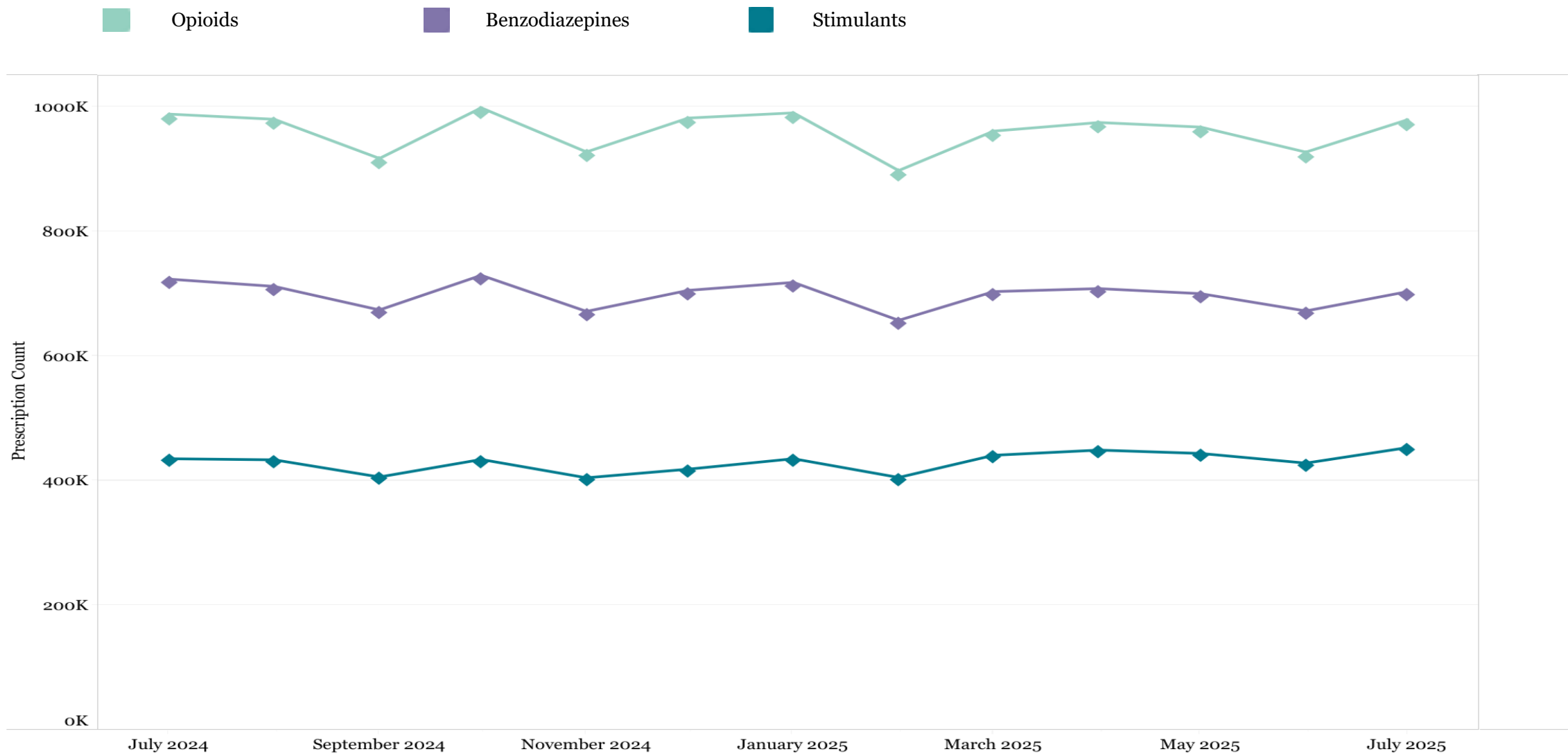
Florida, 2022-2024

Florida, 2024-2025



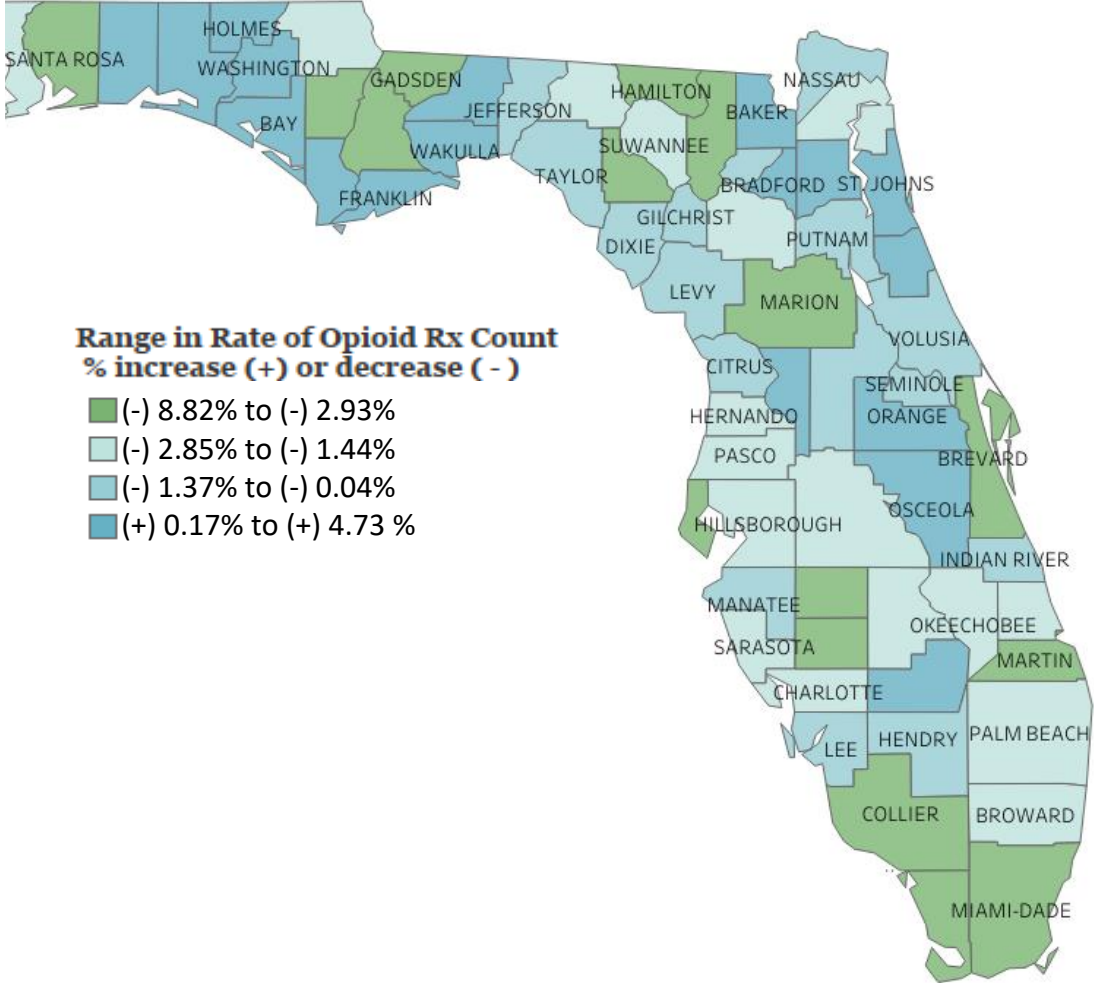
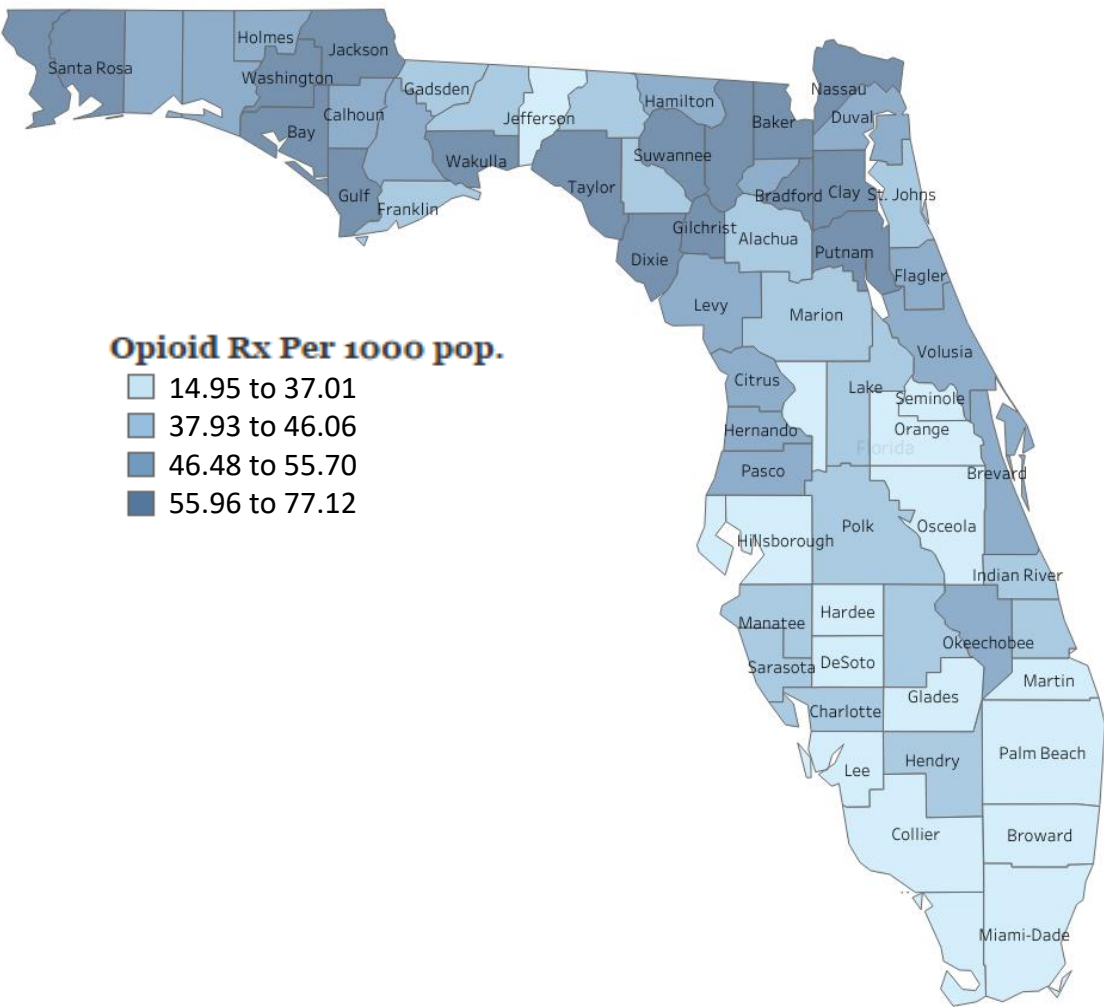

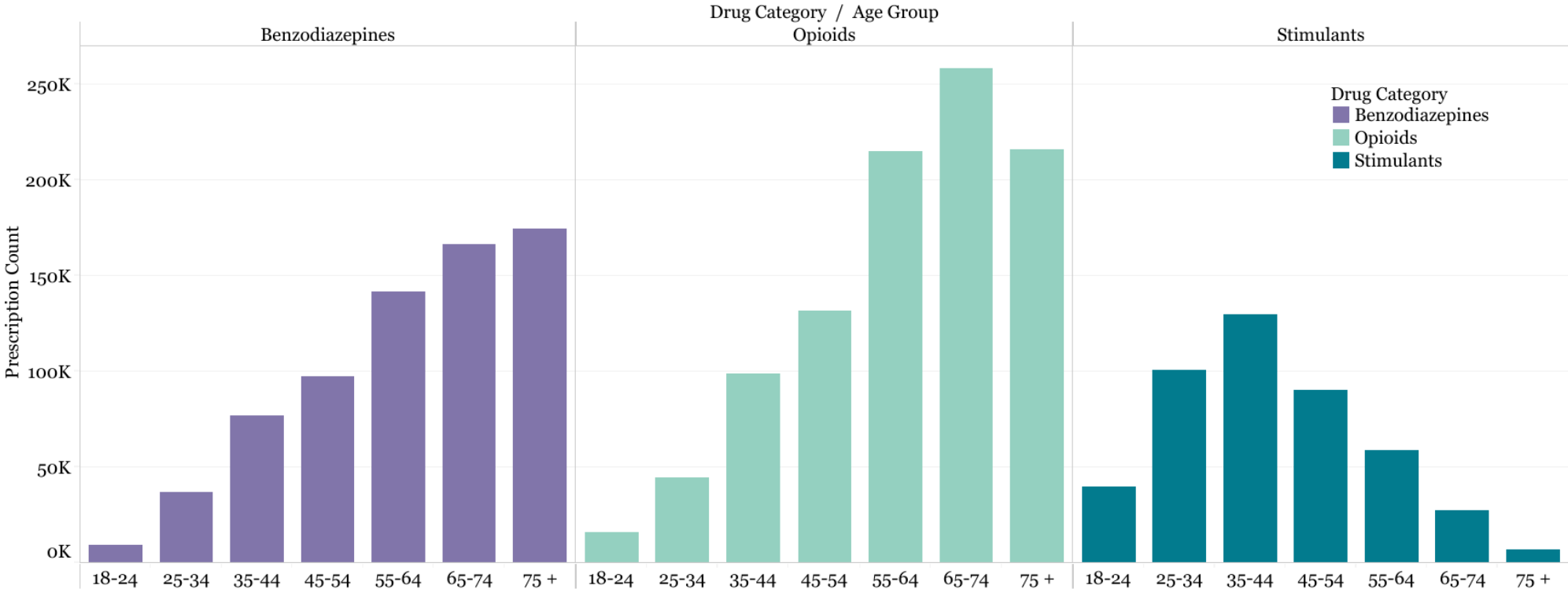
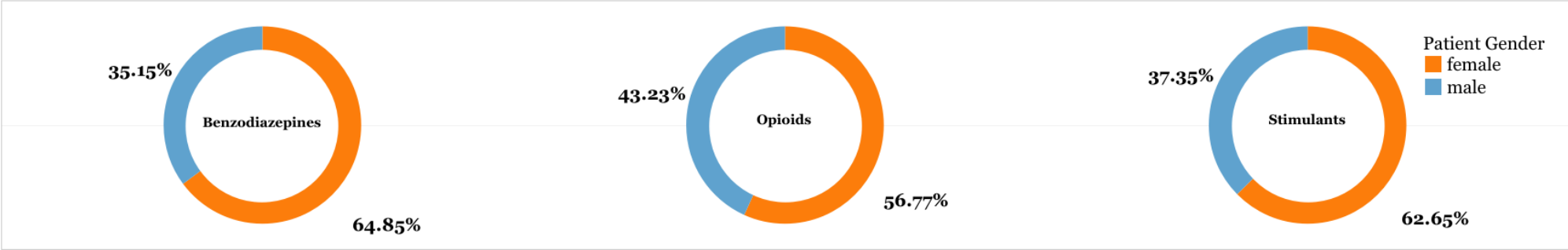
Age-Adjusted Opioid Prescription Rate by County, Florida
