

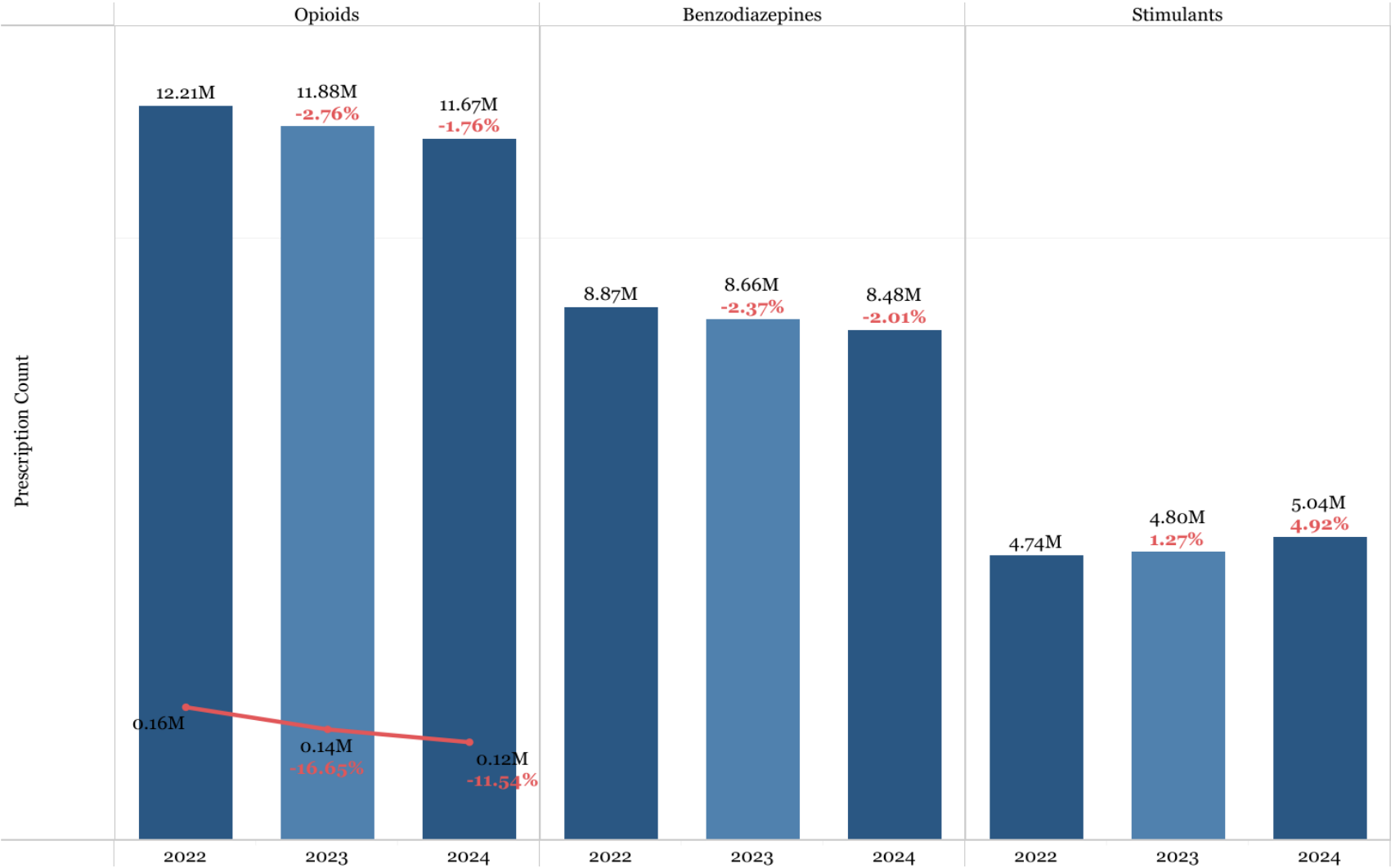
Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

Prescriptions by Drug Type & Year

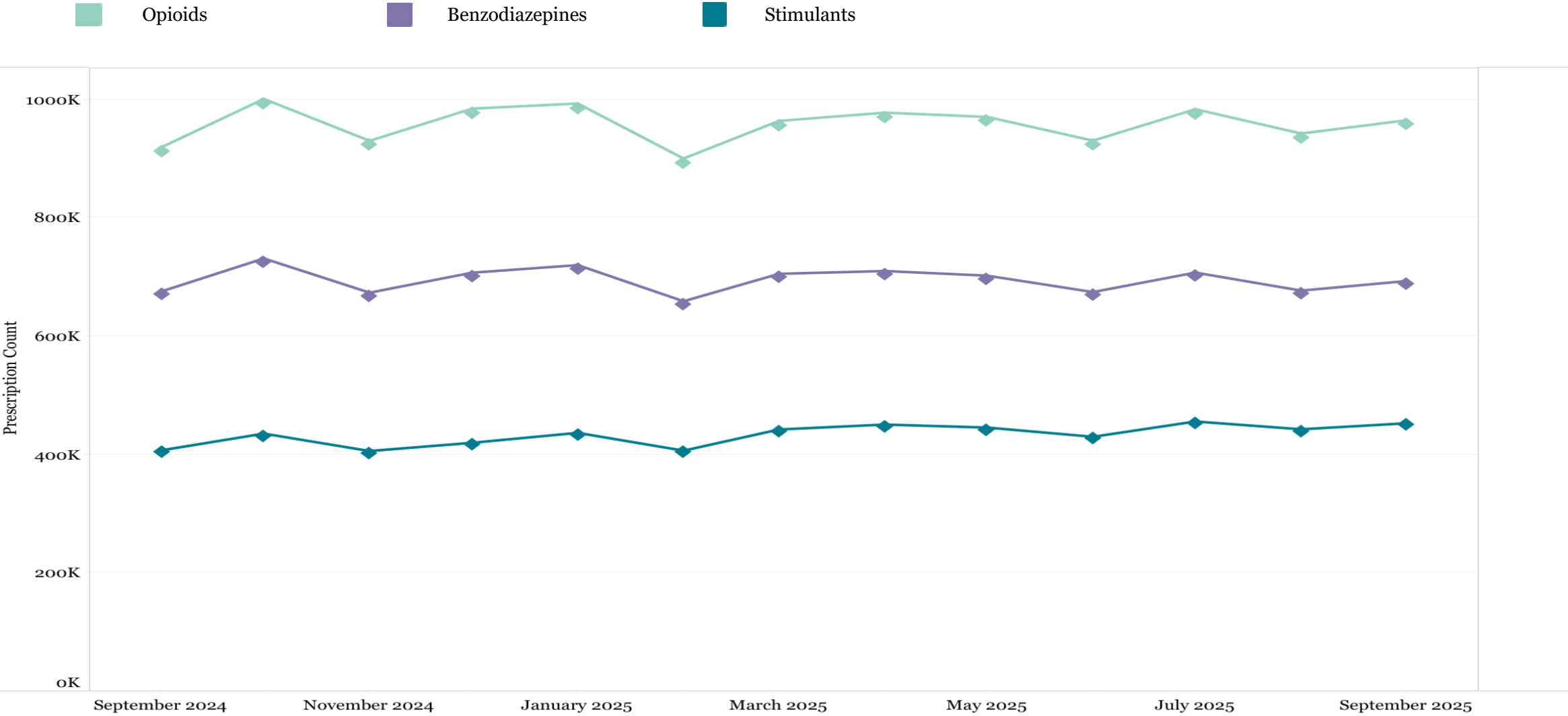

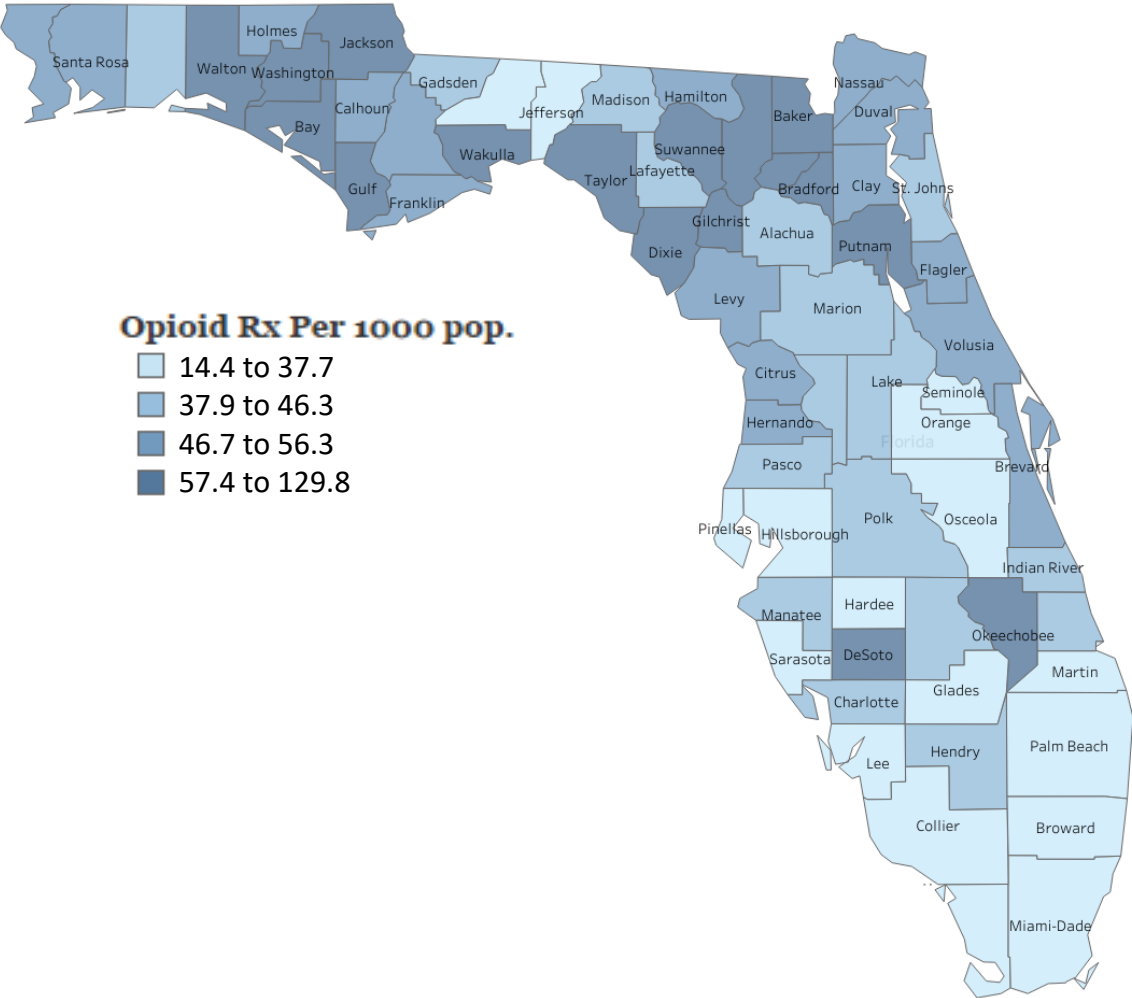

Opioid Prescription Rate & Percent Change by County

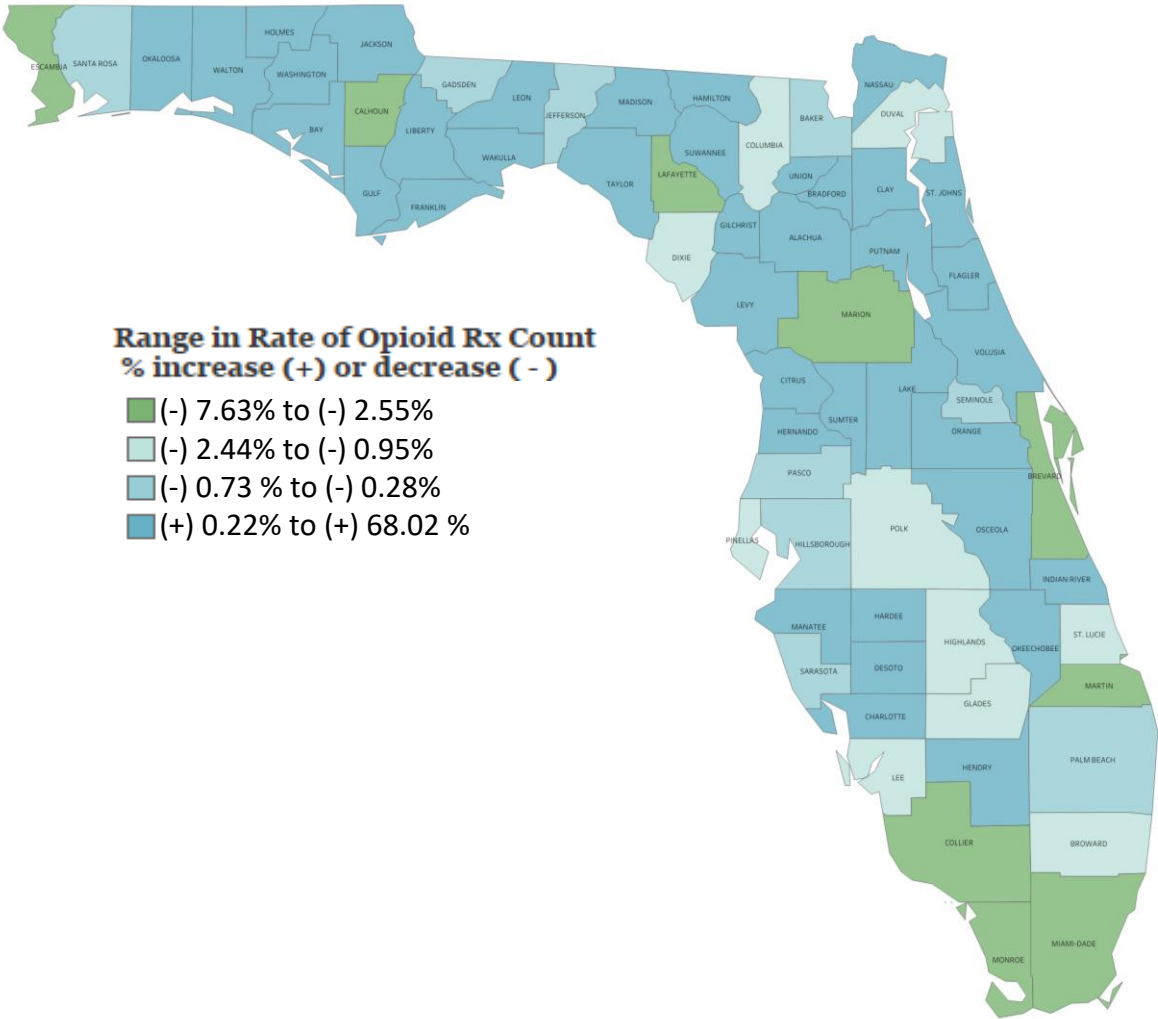

September 2025



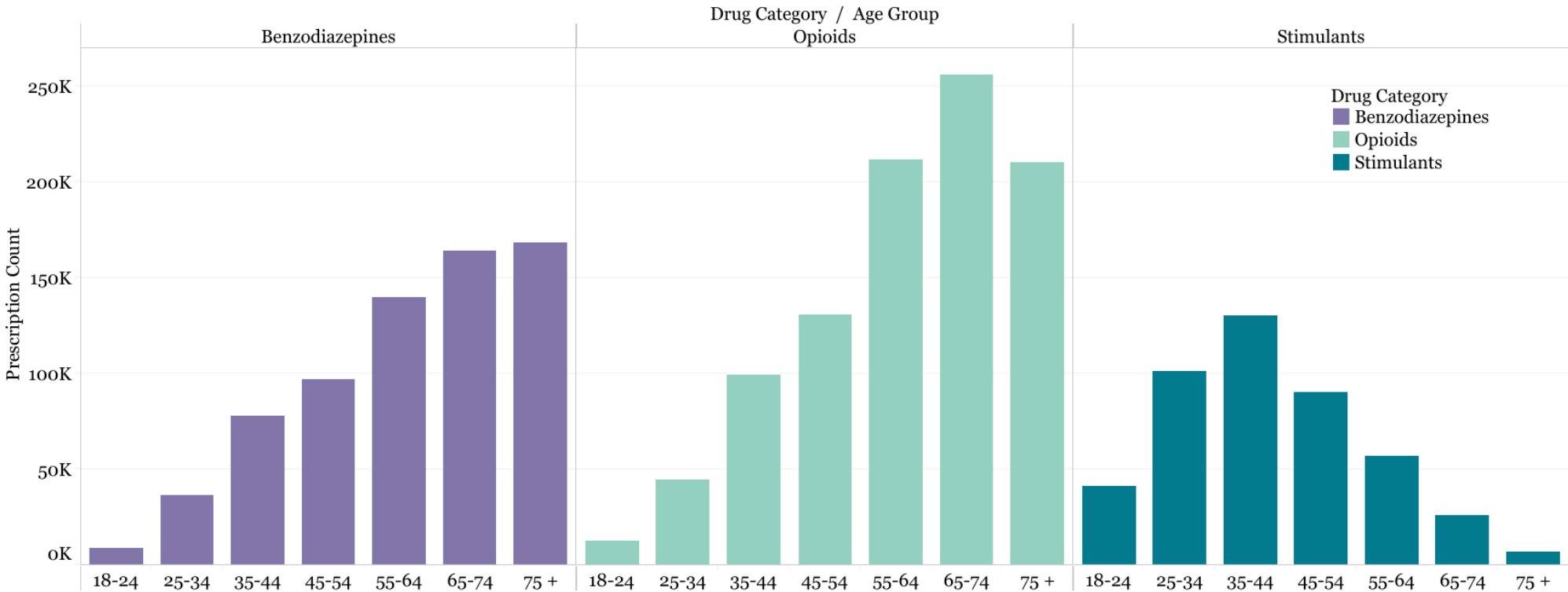
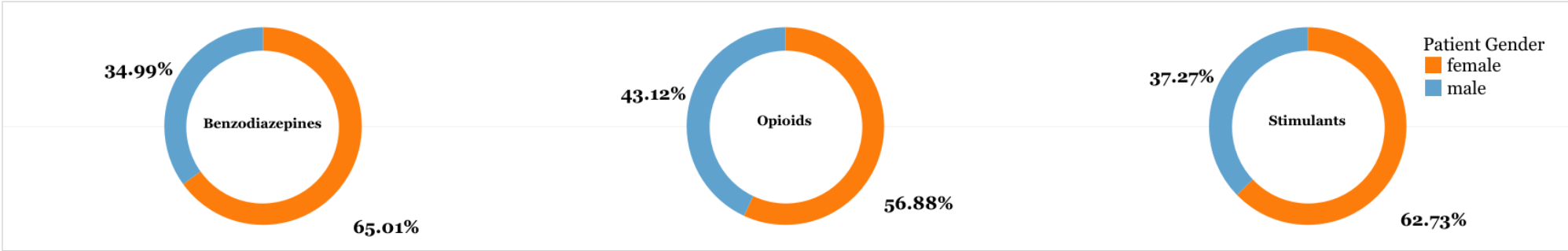
