The Florida Department of Health is pleased to release the 2007 Florida Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) State and County Data Report. This historic surveillance effort would not have been possible without the support of Florida's 67 County Health Departments (CHDs).

The 2007 county-level BRFSS is the first since the initial county-level effort in 2002. The 2007 county-level survey was developed in collaboration with state and local representatives and better designed to meet the needs of CHD programs by offering options to add county-developed questions and increase sample sizes. In addition, 2007 county-level questionnaires included all of the questions asked on a state level, unlike 2002 in which an abbreviated questionnaire was administered.

Over 39,000 interviews were completed in the 2007 calendar year, with a target sample size of 500 completed surveys in each county. Three counties provided funding to increase overall sample sizes: Duval, Highlands, and Sarasota. Through funding from the Hispanic Obesity Prevention Education Program (HOPE), larger samples of Hispanic populations were possible in eight counties: Collier, DeSoto, Hardee, Hendry, Miami-Dade, Okeechobee, Orange, and Osceola. Five counties provided county-added questions: Clay, Collier, Duval, Monroe, and Orange.

The 2007 BRFSS provides counties and the state with a rich data source to estimate the prevalence of personal health behaviors that contribute to morbidity and mortality among adults in Florida. This report presents the survey data on a variety of issues related to health status, health care access, lifestyle, chronic illnesses, and disease prevention practice.

These data can be used to: (1) determine priority health issues and identify populations at highest risk for illness, disability, and death; (2) plan and evaluate prevention programs; (3) educate the community and policy makers about disease prevention; and (4) support community policies that promote health and prevent disease.

Because BRFSS respondents are randomly selected, measures of prevalence and mean are subject to random sample errors. Each measure listed in the data tables includes the 95% confidence interval (CI). Measures of prevalence and mean are excluded from the tables for any subpopulation with a sample size less than 30, which would yield statistically unreliable estimates. Available measures from the 2002 county-level survey are included for comparison purposes. Due to updated methods from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, some point estimates included in the 2002 BRFSS report may be slightly different than the 2002 measures in this report. The methods used to calculate the 2002 point estimates were updated to provide the best comparison between the two years. The significance of measures with very wide 95% confidence intervals should be interpreted with caution.

### GLOSSARY

<b>A1C Test</b>	A blood test used as an indicator of an individual's average blood glucose level over the past three months.
<b>Activities of Daily Living</b>	Usual activities, such as self-care, work, and recreation.
<b>Binge Drinking</b>	Consuming four or more alcoholic drinks for women and five or more alcoholic drinks for men on one occasion.
<b>Blood Pressure Control Measures</b>	Taking prescribed medication, altering diet, exercising, and reducing body weight to control blood pressure.
<b>Blood Stool Test</b>	A test that may use a special kit at home to determine whether the stool contains blood.
<b>Body Mass Index (BMI)</b>	A measure used to estimate the amount of excess body weight. BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
<b>Chronic Joint Symptoms</b>	Experiencing pain, aching, or stiffness in or around a joint that first began more than three months ago.
<b>Current Smokers</b>	Adults who have ever smoked at least 100 cigarettes and who smoked on some or all days in the previous 30 days.
<b>Digital Rectal Exam</b>	An exam in which a doctor, nurse, or other health professional places a gloved finger into the rectum to feel the size, shape, and hardness of the prostate gland.
<b>Former Smokers</b>	Adults who have ever smoked at least 100 cigarettes, but did not smoke on any of the previous 30 days.
<b>Health Insurance Coverage</b>	Includes health insurance, prepaid plans such as HMOs, and government plans such as Medicare.
<b>Healthy Weight</b>	Having a Body Mass Index (BMI) between 18.5 and 24.9. BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
<b>Heavy Drinking (also called chronic drinking)</b>	In the previous 30 days, women consuming an average of one or more alcoholic drinks per day or men consuming an average of two or more alcoholic drinks per day.
<b>High Risk Hepatitis B Groups</b>	Those who have hemophilia and have received clotting factor concentrate, had sex with a man who has had sex with other men, used intravenous street drugs, traded sex for money or drugs, tested positive for HIV, had two or more sex partners in the past year, or who had sex with anyone who would be categorized in any of these groups listed.
<b>High Risk Influenza Groups</b>	Health care workers who routinely have direct contact with patients or adults who currently have health problems such as asthma, lung problems, heart problems, diabetes, kidney problems, weakened immune systems (caused by a chronic illness, such as cancer or HIV/AIDS, or medicines, such as steroids), or sickle cell anemia or other anemia.
<b>Joint Symptoms</b>	Experiencing pain, aching, or stiffness in or around a joint.
<b>Leisure-Time Physical Activity or Exercise</b>	Engaging in any physical activities or exercises such as running, calisthenics, golf, gardening, or walking for exercise, other than participation in these activities or exercise as part of a regular job.
<b>Medical Checkup</b>	A general physical exam, not an exam for a specific injury, illness, or condition.
<b>Moderate Physical Activity</b>	Engaging in activities such as brisk walking, bicycling, vacuuming, gardening, or anything else that causes some increase in breathing or heart rate for at least 30 minutes per day on five or more days per week.
<b>Obese</b>	Having a Body Mass Index (BMI) that is greater than or equal to 30.0. BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.

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### GLOSSARY

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<b>Overweight</b>	Having a Body Mass Index (BMI) ranging from 25.0 to 29.9. BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
<b>Overweight or Obese</b>	Having a Body Mass Index (BMI) that is greater than or equal to 25.0.
<b>Pap Test</b>	A cervical cancer screening test in which surface cells from the cervix are examined for cancer or pre-cancer characteristics.
<b>Poor Mental Health</b>	Adults who report that their mental health, which includes stress, depression, and problems with emotions, was not good on 14 or more of the previous 30 days.
<b>Poor Physical Health</b>	Adults who report that their physical health, which includes physical illness and injury, was not good on 14 or more of the previous 30 days.
<b>PSA Test</b>	A Prostate-Specific Antigen test, also called a PSA test, is a blood test used to detect prostate cancer.
<b>Secondhand Smoke</b>	Being exposed to someone else's tobacco smoke in a room (at work or home) during the past seven days.
<b>Sedentary</b>	Engaging in no leisure-time physical activity.
<b>Sigmoidoscopy/Colonoscopy</b>	Exams in which a tube is inserted in the rectum to view the colon for signs of cancer or other health problems.
<b>Vigorous Physical Activity</b>	Engaging in vigorous activities, such as running, aerobics, heavy yard work, or anything else that causes large increases in breathing or heart rate for at least 20 minutes per day on three or more days per week.

14-29. Increase the proportion of adults who are vaccinated annually against influenza and ever vaccinated against pneumococcal disease.

### Overweight & Obesity

19-2. Reduce the proportion of adults who are obese.

19-1. Increase the proportion of adults who are at a healthy weight.

### Physical Activity & Nutrition

22-3. Increase the proportion of adults who engage in vigorous physical activity that promotes the development and maintenance of cardiorespiratory fitness 3 or more days per week for 20 or more minutes per occasion.

22-2. Increase the proportion of adults who engage regularly, preferably daily, in moderate physical activity for at least 30 minutes per day.

22-1. Reduce the proportion of adults who engage in no leisure-time physical activity.

19-5. Increase the proportion of persons aged 2 years and older who consume at least two daily servings of fruit.

19-6. Increase the proportion of persons aged 2 years and older who consume at least three daily servings of vegetables, with at least one-third being dark green or orange vegetables.

### Sexual Violence

15-35. Reduce the annual rate of rape or attempted rape.

15-36. Reduce sexual assault other than rape.

### Tobacco Use & Exposure

27-10. Reduce the proportion of non-smokers exposed to environmental tobacco smoke.

27-5. Increase smoking cessation attempts by adult smokers.
