Fish consumption advisories are published by the Florida Department of Health to provide information about the possibility of health impacts from specific fish species caught in Florida's waters.



Information About this Guidebook

Fish can be part of a healthy diet. Along with being rich in vitamins and low in fat, fish contains healthy protein. Eating fish low in contamination is part of a heart-healthy dietary pattern, especially for young children and women during pregnancy.

Most freshwater fish caught in Florida can be eaten without harm. Bream (such as bluegill, redear sunfish, redbreast sunfish or spotted sunfish) and marine fish (such as mullet, flounder, and Atlantic croaker) are generally lower in chemical concentration, including mercury.

Florida state agencies work together to analyze fish tissue. Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission biologists collect and prepare the fish for testing. Florida Department of Environmental Protection, or an overflow lab, test the fish following U.S. Environmental Protection Agency laboratory standards.

Fish in Florida have been tested for chemicals such as mercury, arsenic, pesticides, and other contaminants. The chemicals may increase in amounts or bioaccumulate over time (as the fish are exposed and as fish age), which may impact health when consumed. Based on test results, the Florida Department of Health determines safe consumption guidelines for different species of fish, within different waterbodies.

These guidelines help reduce the risk of health effects. The chemicals tested are known to impact health if consumed in high amounts and for a long duration of time. The Florida Department of Health completes the calculation using information such as amount of contaminant detected, average body weight of adults, and contaminant-specific reference information to determine the consumption limits.

Looking up guidelines for the fish you plan to catch and eat. To find current guidelines, look for the water body that you are fishing in to see if the species that you caught is listed. If the fish species is not listed in the water body it was caught in, look at nearby waterbodies for guidelines on consumption (mercury). For other chemicals, such as pesticides, guidelines will be more specific to each water body.

Do not look at each fish consumption advisory individually, but instead, combined. As an example, if two different fish species fall under the 'two meals per week' category, you should not consume more than two fish total in a week, regardless of fish species. This means you can have two of one species or one of each different species during a week. Use the most restrictive category when determining how much you should consume.

The guidebook has **five different categories:**

- 2 meals per week** = you can eat 8 ounces of fish twice in that week, and no other fish.
- 1 meal per week** = you can eat 8 ounces of fish one in that week, and no other fish.
- 2 meals per month** = you can eat 8 ounces of fish twice in that month, and no other fish.
- 1 meal per month** = you can eat 8 ounces of fish once in that month, and no other fish.
- Do Not Consume** = you can catch these fish, but do not eat them.

When eating fish from waterbodies under an advisory, you should space out your meals based on the advice provided. Cooking will not remove chemicals from the fish.

A person's weight can help decide how much fish they can eat.

For people that weigh 180 pounds, a meal is considered 6 ounces of cooked fish or 8 ounces of uncooked fish. Depending on your weight, the ounces of fish to safely eat may be more if you weigh over 180 pounds or less if you are under 180 pounds.

It is possible to reduce the health risks from contaminated fish. Just remember your **H.E.A.L.T.H.**


- **Have** current recommendations
- **Eat** safely
- **Avoid** contaminants
- **Limit** specific fish
- **Two** meals of fish a week is recommended
- **Health** is key

There are ways to reduce some risks of eating contaminated parts of fish by cleaning or cooking fish to reduce fat.

- Remove head and all guts.
- Remove the skin and trim all fat from the areas shown in the figure on the right.
- Don't pan-fry or deep fry. Broil, bake, poach, or boil your fish so the fatty juices drip away.
- Don't eat or use any of the cooking liquids.



We have made some updates to this guidebook.

Without good studies to understand what concentrations of mercury affect the general public, we have removed one category from the list of advisories. However, we added a table to explain how much a person can safely eat based on their weight (found on page 4). We also added more information about how the advisories are calculated.

In addition, Florida bass has now been designated a separate species from largemouth bass. Florida bass and largemouth bass will be considered within the same species for regulation purposes since they are visually indistinguishable. Learn more about bass by visiting MyFWC.com.

PUFFER FISH

There are some fish that you should avoid entirely, as they contain toxins at harmful amounts. These include the southern puffer, northern puffer, marbled puffer, bandtail puffer, checkered puffer, and least puffer.

Eating puffer fish (also called blowfish) can cause saxitoxin poisoning which can lead to neurological symptoms such as tingling, drowsiness, incoherent speech, and difficulty breathing. In severe cases, the poisoning can cause death. Saxitoxin has no taste, color, or smell. If you experience any of the symptoms, contact your physician or visit the emergency room immediately.

According to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, it is illegal from harvesting puffer fish caught in Volusia, Brevard, Indian River, St. Lucie, and Martin counties.

Calculating Fish Consumption Advisory Levels

The Florida Department of Health uses the chemical concentration results for eight or more specific type of fish per water body to calculate a safe consumption amount and advisory. Consumption advisories are reported as the recommended maximum number of meals a person can eat per week or month or as "Do Not Consume."

Consumption advisories are dependent on an individual's body weight and on fish size, per meal. A larger meal size will lead to a higher chemical concentration consumed. People with a higher body weight can tolerate a larger meal size than people with a lower body weight. As body weight changes, the meal size can change while keeping the risk level the same.

Non-Cancer Fish Consumption Advisory Calculations

Fish consumption advisories are calculated using equations from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) guidance for Assessing Chemical Contaminant Data for Use in Fish Advisories, Volume 1 and Volume 2, November 2000 [EPA 2000]. These equations calculate the daily chemical dose a person is exposed to (the amount of chemical per body weight per day).

The equations also consider the chemical concentration in the collected fish and chemical-specific toxicity guidelines obtained from EPA's Integrated Risk Information System [EPA 2022]. The equations consider the meal size and human body weight for non-cancer effects.

Fish Consumption Advisory Levels

Working with our state partners, the Florida Department of Health obtains the test results for the chemical tested (e.g. mercury, pesticide, arsenic, etc.) in each sample of fish tissue. The Florida Department of Health uses the concentration per fish species, per water body, such as calculating the 95% upper confidence limit (95% UCL) of the **mean chemical concentration** in muscle tissue to use in Equation 1 below. The 95% UCL is a statistical estimate that equals or exceeds the actual mean 95% of the time and has a very low (5%) chance of underestimating exposure [ATSDR 2022].

EQUATION 1: Meals per Month Based on Non-Cancer Health Effects

$$\text{Meals per Month} = \frac{\text{RfD (mg/kg/day)} \times \text{BW (kg)} \times \text{Time (days/mo)}}{\text{Contaminant Conc (mg/kg)} \times \text{Meal (kg/meal)}}$$

RfD = Reference Dose calculated by EPA

mg/kg/day = Milligram of Contaminant per kilogram per day

BW = Average body weight of an adult

kg = Kilogram

Time = Average number of days in a month (30.44 days per month)

days/mo = Days per month

Contaminant Conc = Amount of chemical contaminant in the meat tested

mg/kg = Milligram per kilogram

Meal = Set size of the meal in kg (8 oz or .227 kg)

kg/meal = Kilogram per meal

The Florida Department of Health uses an adult body weight of 180 pounds. This is about the average body weight for U.S. citizens between the ages of 18 to 65 years. The body weight is based on the National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES) [EPA 2015]. EPA lists the typical meal size as 8 ounces of uncooked fish [EPA 2000].

In addition, the Florida Department of Health uses an EPA's reference dose (RfD) or ATSDR minimal risk level for the chemical that was analyzed. The list of chemicals and their respective value is seen in Table 3. EPA's RfD is an estimate of a daily exposure of a specific chemical that is not likely to lead to adverse health effects in humans, including sensitive subgroups, during a lifetime (EPA estimates at 70 years) [EPA 2022].

The results of Equation 1, in meals per month, would lead us to the amount of fish one could consume while not increasing the risk of non-cancer health effects. For carcinogenic chemicals, this result was also compared to the cancer health effects limit. **The more limited result was used for the final consumption recommendations.**

Cancer Risk Fish Consumption Advisory Calculations

Some chemicals are carcinogenic, which means the chemical may cause cancer if one is exposed to high enough amounts. To determine safe consumption limits based on cancer health effects, in terms of meals per month, the Florida Department of Health uses the equations in EPA's guidance for Assessing Chemical Contaminant Data for Use in Fish Advisories, Volume 1 and Volume 2, November 2000 [EPA 2000] regarding cancer effects.

In addition to both considering the meal size and average adult body weight, Equation 2 uses oral slope values for the specific chemical and a reference risk level for cancer effects (Table 3). Equation 3 uses the calculated consumption rate limit to determine the meals per month category.

EQUATION 2: Consumption Rate Limits per Fish Species Based on Cancer Health Effects

$$\text{Consumption Rate Limit} = \frac{\text{Risk Level (unitless)} \times \text{BW (kg)}}{\sum (\text{Contaminant Conc (mg/kg)} / \text{Contaminant Oral Slope (mg/kg/day)})}$$

Consumption Rate Limit =	Maximum allowable daily limit
Risk Level =	An estimate of the daily human exposure to a hazardous substance that is likely to be without appreciable risk of adverse health effects over a specified duration of exposure.
BW =	Average body weight of adults
kg =	Kilogram
Contaminant Conc =	Maximum or 95% UCL value
mg/kg =	Milligram per kilogram
Contaminant Oral Slope =	Chemical-specific standard
mg/kg/day =	Milligram per kilogram per day

EQUATION 3: Meals per Month Based on Cancer Health Effects

$$\text{Meals per Month} = \frac{\text{Consumption Rate Limit} \times \text{Time (days/mo)}}{\text{Meal (kg/meal)}}$$

Consumption Rate Limit =	Maximum allowable daily limit
Time =	Average number of days in a month (30.44 days per month)
days/mo =	Days per month
Meal =	Set size of the meal in kg
kg/meal =	Kilogram per meal

In addition, the Florida Department of Health uses the concentration per fish species per water body such as calculating the 95% upper confidence limit (95% UCL) of the **mean chemical concentration** in muscle tissue. The 95% UCL is a statistical estimate that equals or exceeds the actual mean 95% of the time and has a very low (5%) chance of underestimating exposure [ATSDR 2022].

In addition, the Florida Department of Health uses the guideline (cancer slope factor or oral slope) used to evaluate increased cancer risk for each chemical that is carcinogenic. Table 3 lists the known oral slope values used in the calculations if the specific chemical was detected. If the type of cancer formed is the same for multiple chemicals, the concentrations and oral slopes for the different chemicals are both utilized to calculate the consumption rate limit. This result is used to determine the meals per month consumption recommendations.
