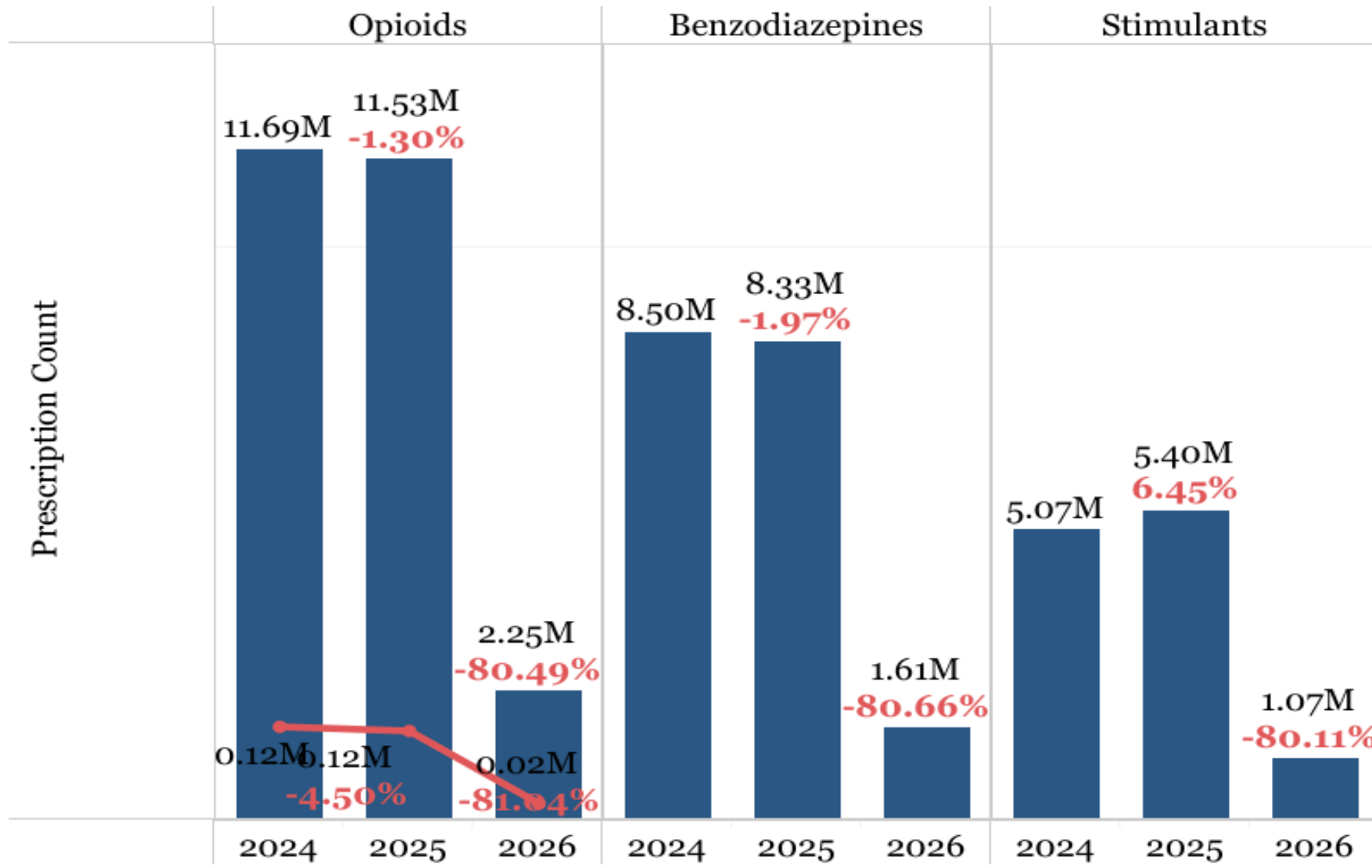

# Prescriptions by Drug Type & Year

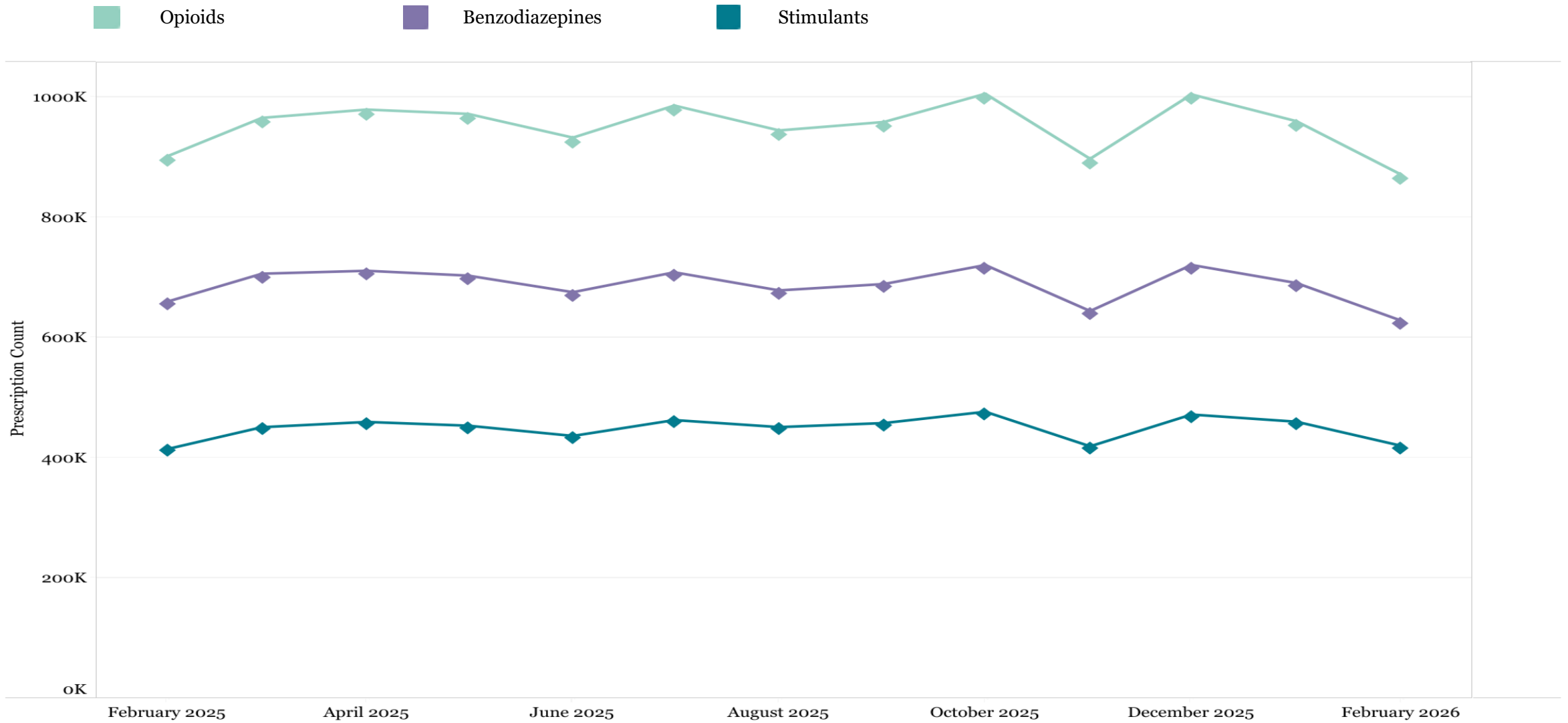

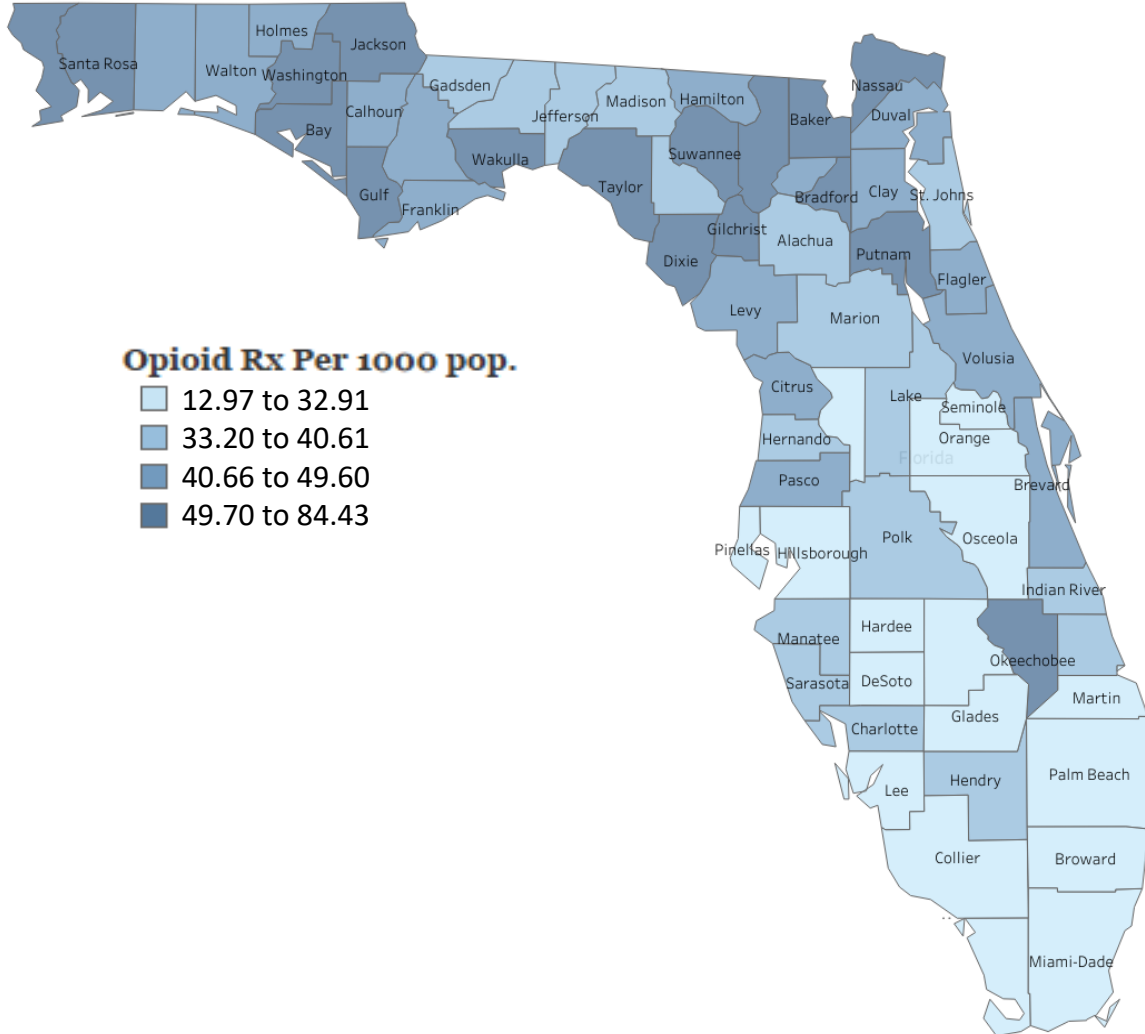

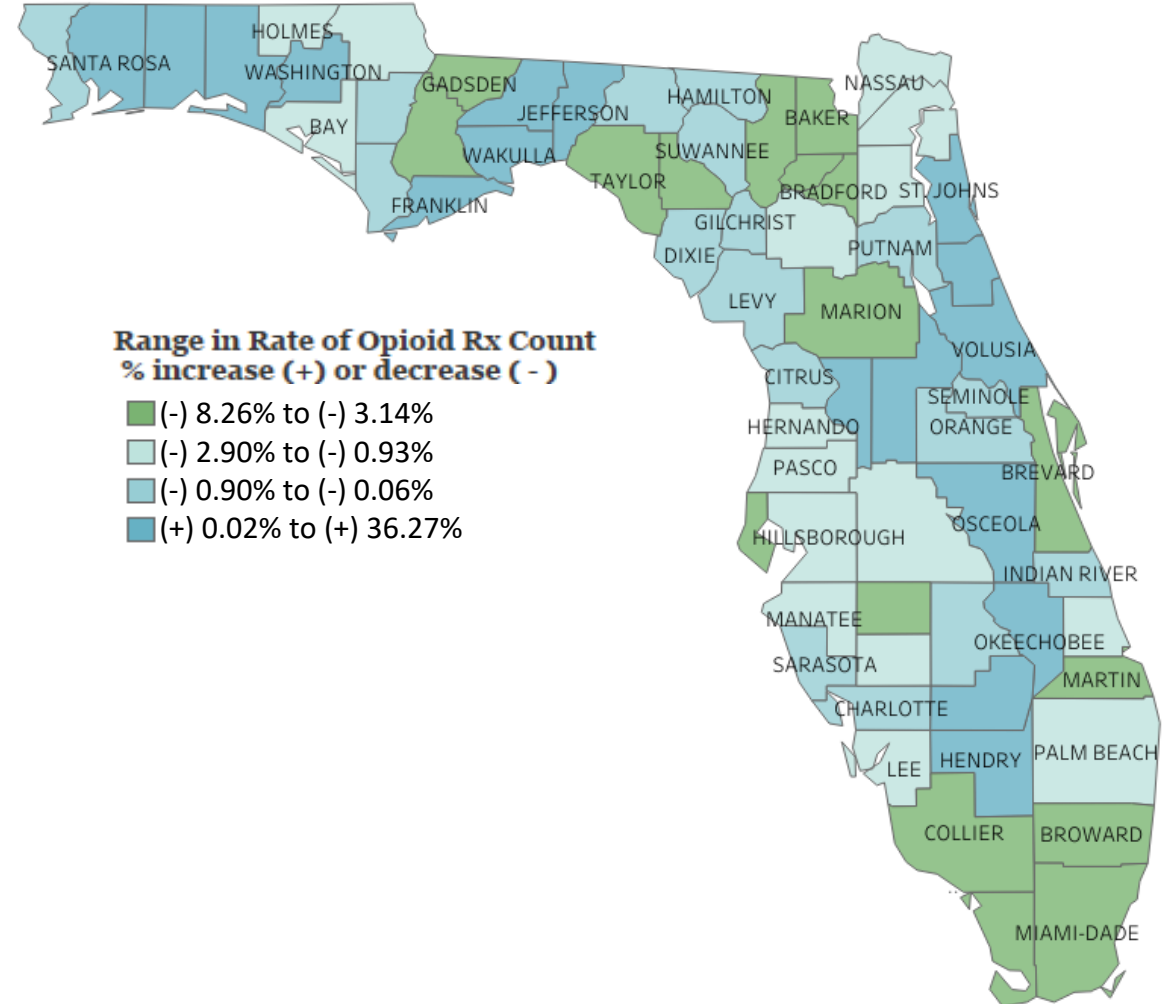
# Opioid Prescription Rate & Percent Change by County

February 2026**

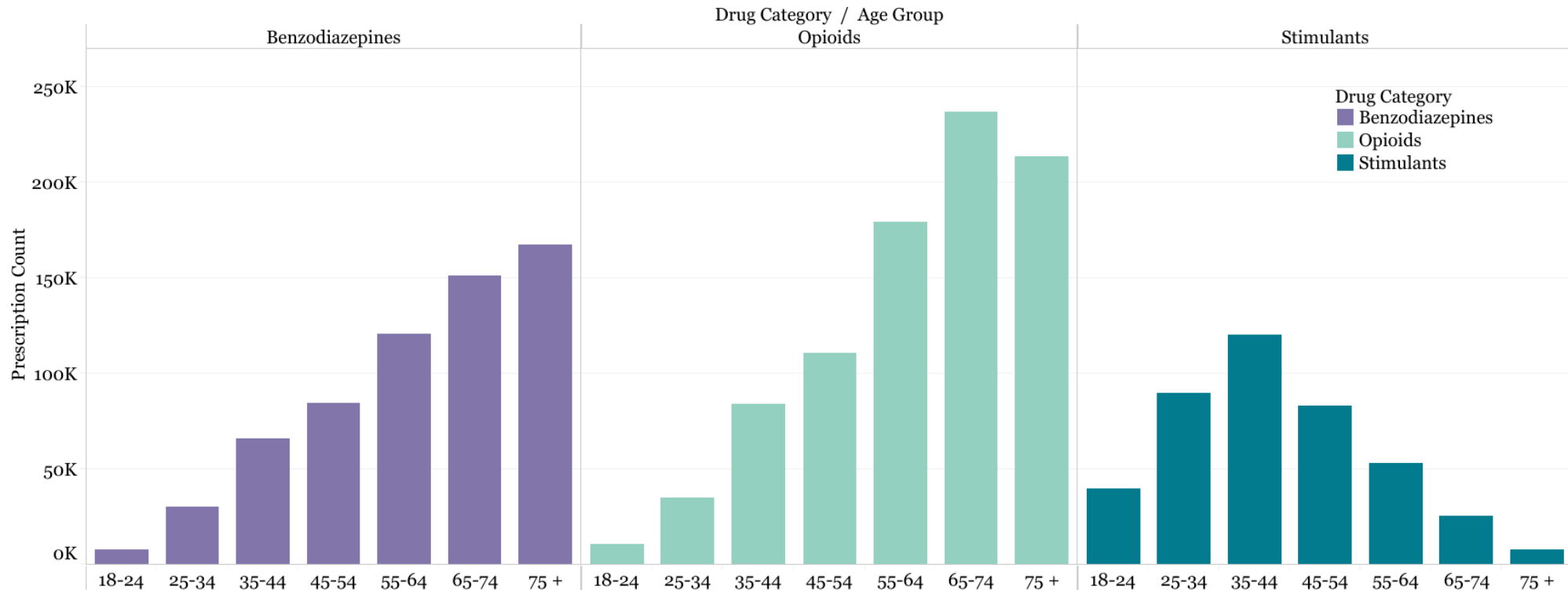
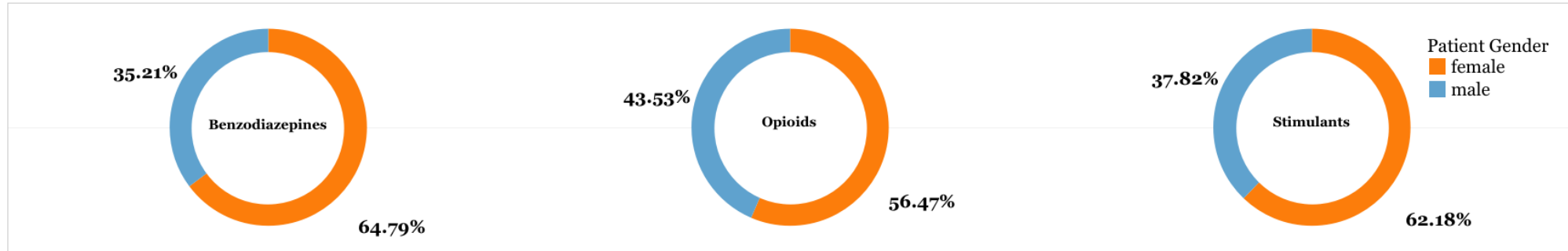


**Percent Change in Opioid Prescription Count by County, Florida

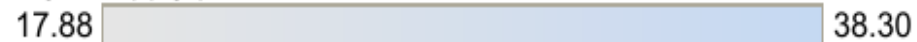
